Subject: Community Project Funding Request

Dear Congressman Thompson,

Thank you for the opportunity to submit a project for consideration for the subject funding, and by way of this correspondence I respectfully nominate the following project.

<u>Project Name</u>: South Main Street/Soda Bay Road Widening and Resurfacing Project, County of Lake in the unincorporated area of South Lakeport, California, Congressional District 4

Project Description and Benefits: This project will result in the construction of a continuous center left-turn lane and bicycle lanes on both sides of the roadway for the entire South Main Street/Soda Bay Road Corridor. The center left-turn lane will improve safety throughout the corridor for vehicles attempting to turn into the various businesses on either side of the street where we currently experience a high rate of rear-end accidents. The bicycle lanes will provide safer areas for bicyclists which will promote increased non-motorized transportation through the region. Collectively, these improvements will provide a significant benefit to the businesses and motorists through one of the highest travelled corridors in the County. This project has widespread support and is highly ranked in the Regional Transportation Plan, as evidenced by the attached letter of support from our Area Planning Council.

Amount Requested for the Project: \$5,041,000 (This was determined by taking the current engineer's cost estimate + 10% contingency and subtracting the current available funding)

<u>Total Project Cost</u>: The current State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) project cost estimate is \$5.031 million dollars, however this amount has not been revised over several STIP cycles and the current engineer's construction cost estimate is \$9.156 million.

<u>Project Eligibility</u>: This project is eligible under 23 USC 133(b) (Surface Transportation Block Grant Program).

<u>Estimated Start and Completion Dates</u>: The road construction project is expected to commence in the summer of 2026 and be completed by Fall of 2027.

Has this request been submitted to a federal agency for non-earmarked funds this fiscal year? No

<u>History of any Federal Funding for the project</u>: This project has utilized Federal DEMO funding for various phases of the project. A summary of the funding (Amendment Modification Summary (E-76)) is attached.

<u>Does the project have other public (state or local) funds committed to meet match or cost-share requirements?</u> Yes, the project includes State and local funds, a summary of which is attached (Finance Letter). Local funding is from County Road Department discretionary funds.

If the request does not fully fund the project, describe the source of the remaining funding: Remaining funding will come from County Road Department discretionary funds.

Additionally, the construction of a center lane is anticipated to enhance the flow of traffic and increase safety by providing a buffer for vehicles traveling in opposite directions, reducing rear-end collisions.

The Lake Area Planning Council firmly believes that the successful implementation of the South Main Street/Soda Bay Road Widening Project will improve the regional transportation infrastructure, reflecting our shared commitment to safety, efficiency, and sustainability.
