WHEREAS, the DISTRICT is authorized to enter into an agreement with the Department of Water Resources and the State of California;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Lake County Watershed Protection District appoints the Director of the Water Resources Department as a representative(s) of the Watershed Protection District to conduct negotiations, execute, submit and sign all documents including but not limited to applications, agreements, amendments, payment requests, and other documents which may be necessary for the completion of the proposed project.

That pursuant and subject to all the terms and conditions of the Budget Act of 2024, the
District authorizes the Director of Water Resources, or designee, to execute the funding
agreement with the Department of Water Resources and any amendments thereto; and

 That the Director of Water Resources, or designee, shall prepare the necessary data, make investigations, and take other such actions as necessary and appropriate to obtain funding for the Upper Lake Levee Project.
