APPROVING THE INTENT TO PARTICIPATE IN THE DEFERRED MAINTENANCE PROGRAM TO RECEIVE STATE FUNDS UNDER SECTION 6.10 OF SENATE BILL 826 (STATS. 2016, CH. 23)

WHEREAS, the Legislature and Governor of the State of California have provided funds for the deferred levee maintenance program to help local agencies perform maintenance of levee project and

WHEREAS, the current deferred maintenance involves culvert inspections; and

WHEREAS, the California Department of Water Resources has been delegated the responsibility for establishing the necessary procedures for the administration of this program; and

WHEREAS, said procedures established by the California Department of Water Resources require a resolution certifying the approval of Intent to Participate Letter by the Applicant's governing board before submission to the State; and

WHEREAS, the Applicant, if selected will enter into a Project Agreement with the State of California to implement the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Lake County Watershed Protection District Board of Directors:

- 1. Will accept \$82,080 in state funds to support video inspections of the culverts
- 2. Approves the filing of the Intent to Participate Letter for the Levee Penetrations Maintenance
- 3. Certifies that Applicant understands the assurances and certification required.
- 4. Certifies that Applicant or title holder will have sufficient funds to operate and maintain the project(s) or will secure the resources to do so.
- 5. Certifies that Applicant will comply with all applicable provisions of Labor Code section 1720 et seq.
- 6. Certifies that the Applicant will comply with all applicable laws and regulations including, but not limited to, the *California Environmental Quality Act* (CEQA), state or municipal building codes, health and safety codes, disabled access laws; and, prior to commencement of construction, Applicant will obtain all applicable permits.
- 7. Delegates authority to the Director of the Lake County Watershed Protection District, to serve as Applicant's agent in the negotiations, execution and submission of all documents including, but not limited to applications, agreements and payment
