A RESOLUTION DECLARING INTENT TO ADOPT A RESOLUTION TO VACATE A
PORTION OF COLLIER AVENUE (C.R.#306C), IN THE COUNTY OF LAKE

WHEREAS a petition has been received to vacate a portion of a roadway known
as Collier Avenue located in the Nice area of the County of Lake, State of California;
and

WHEREAS it appears to be in the best interest of the County of Lake to vacate the
portion of said County road; and

WHEREAS it is appropriate to set a date and time for the public hearing to
consider the proposed vacation by the Board of Supervisors;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF
THE COUNTY OF LAKE, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, THAT IT FINDS, DETERMINES,
ORDERS AND HEREBY DECLARES THAT:

1. It is the intention of the Board to vacate the hereinafter described roadway in
the County of Lake, State of California described as follows: A portion of Collier Avenue
(C.R. #306C) lying Southerly of Lakeshore Boulevard (C.R.#306Y) being approximately
220 feet in length and as described in Exhibit "A" attached.

2. Tuesday, the _____ 9th _____ day of _____ July _____ 2024, at _____ 9:45
_____ A.M., is fixed as the time, and the Board of Supervisors Chambers, Courthouse,
Lakeport, California, is fixed as the place for hearing all persons interested in the
proposed vacation.

3. This vacation proceeding is being conducted under the provisions of the
Public Streets, Highways, and Service Easements Vacation Law (Streets and Highways
Code, Section 8321, et. Seq.).

4. The Clerk of the Board is directed to give notice hereof pursuant to Sections 8322 and 8323 of the Streets and Highways Code.
