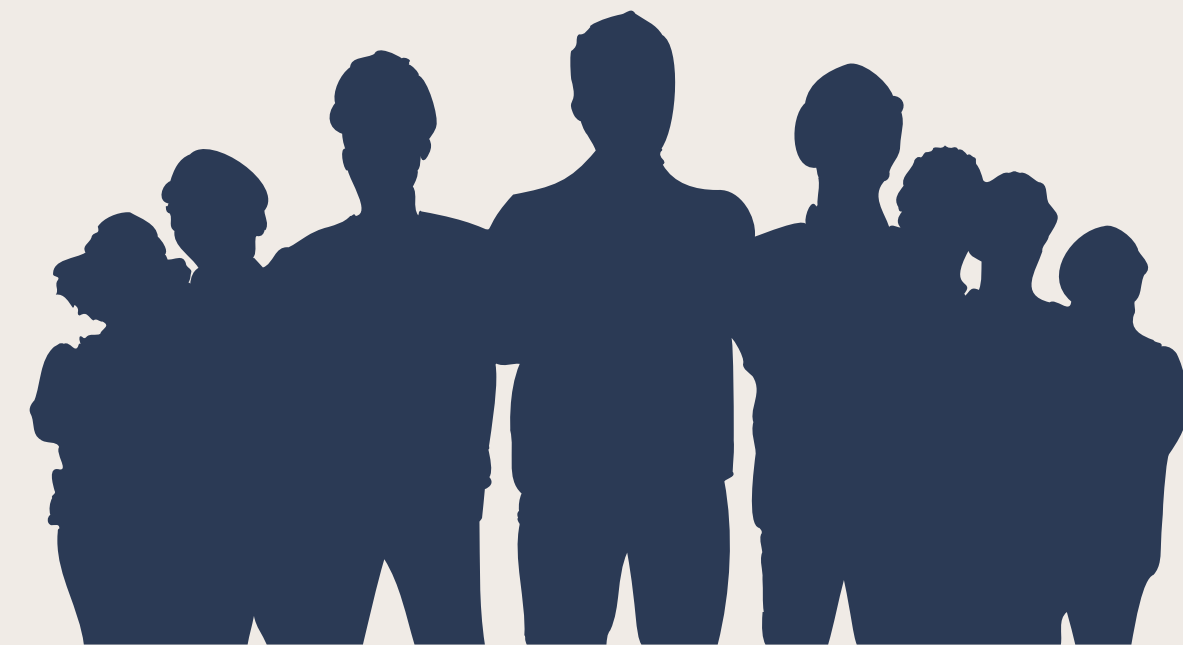

My takeaway is the feeling when you find the answer to a legal question after researching for a while.

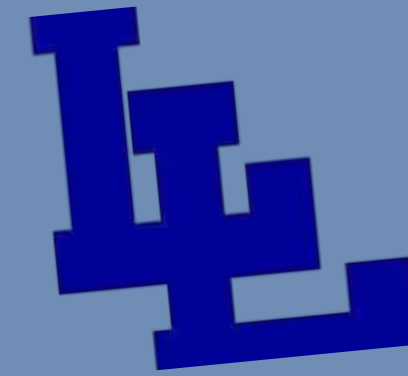
IMPACTS

KEY TAKE AWAYS

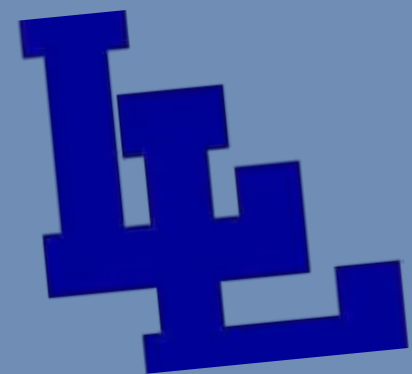
What stood out to me was how many activities and resources were actually provided by the library. My favorite part was doing fun projects with the community.

I really loved the research and design aspects of this internship. I also learned to sometimes expect slow days

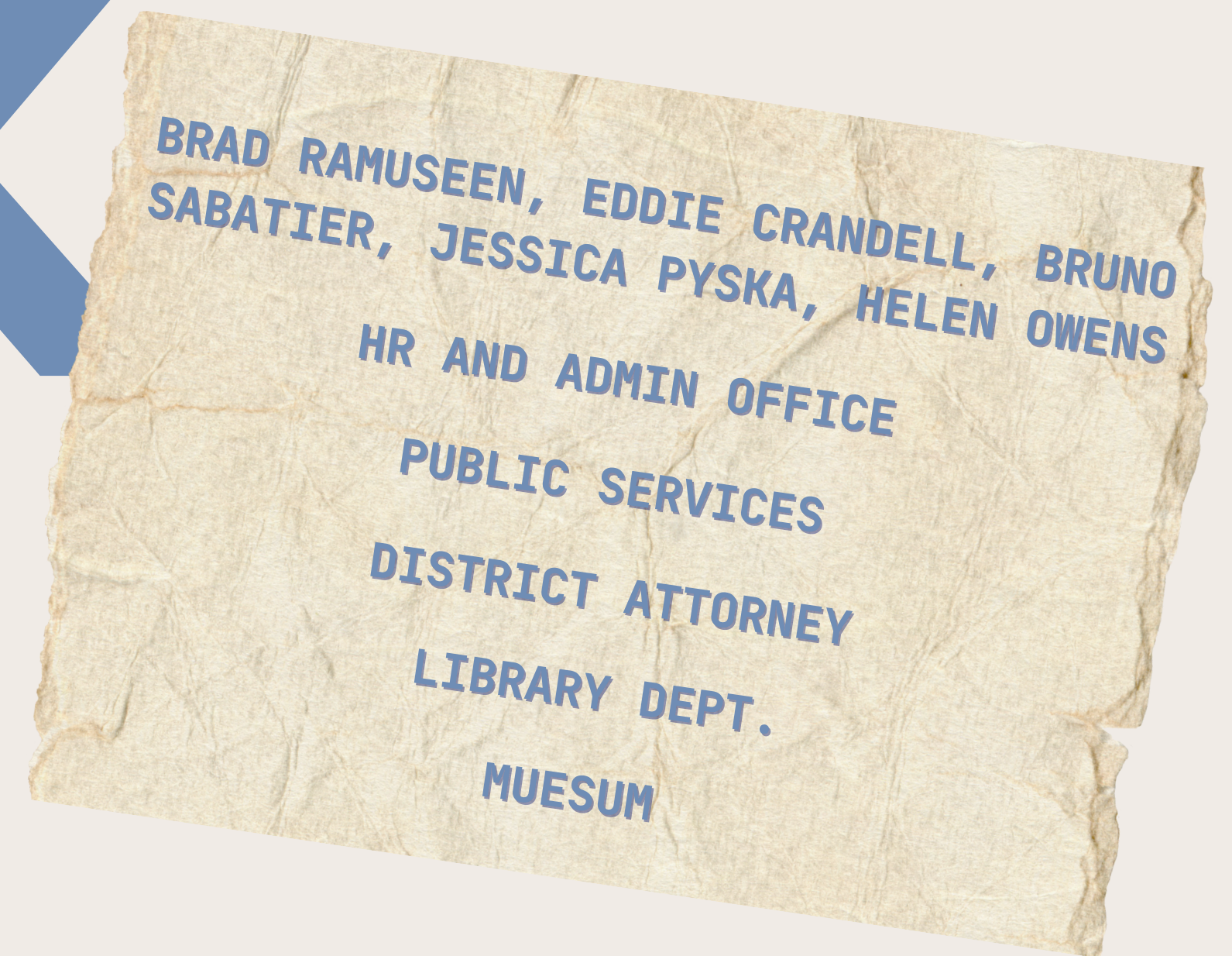
TASKS
