



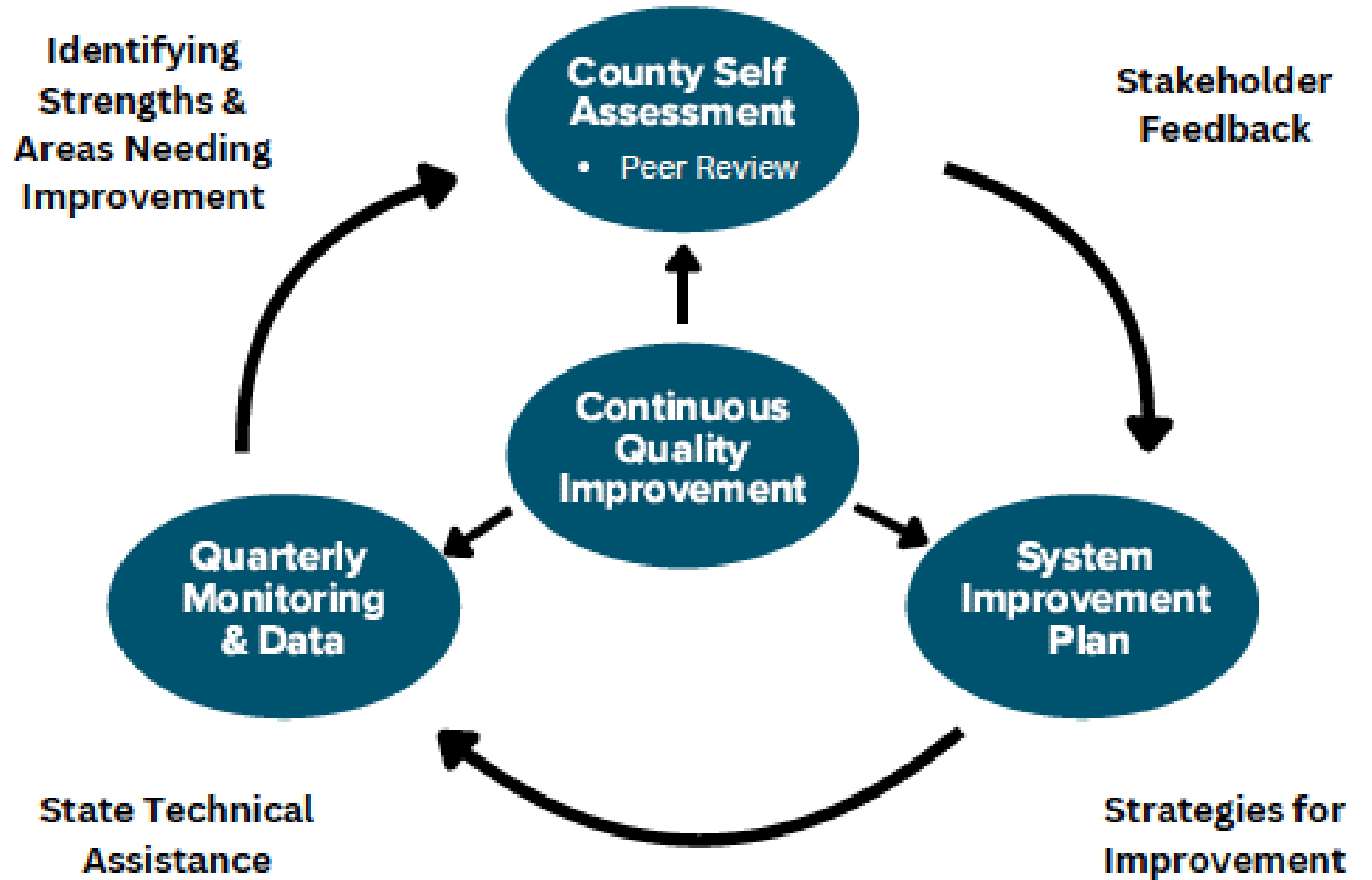

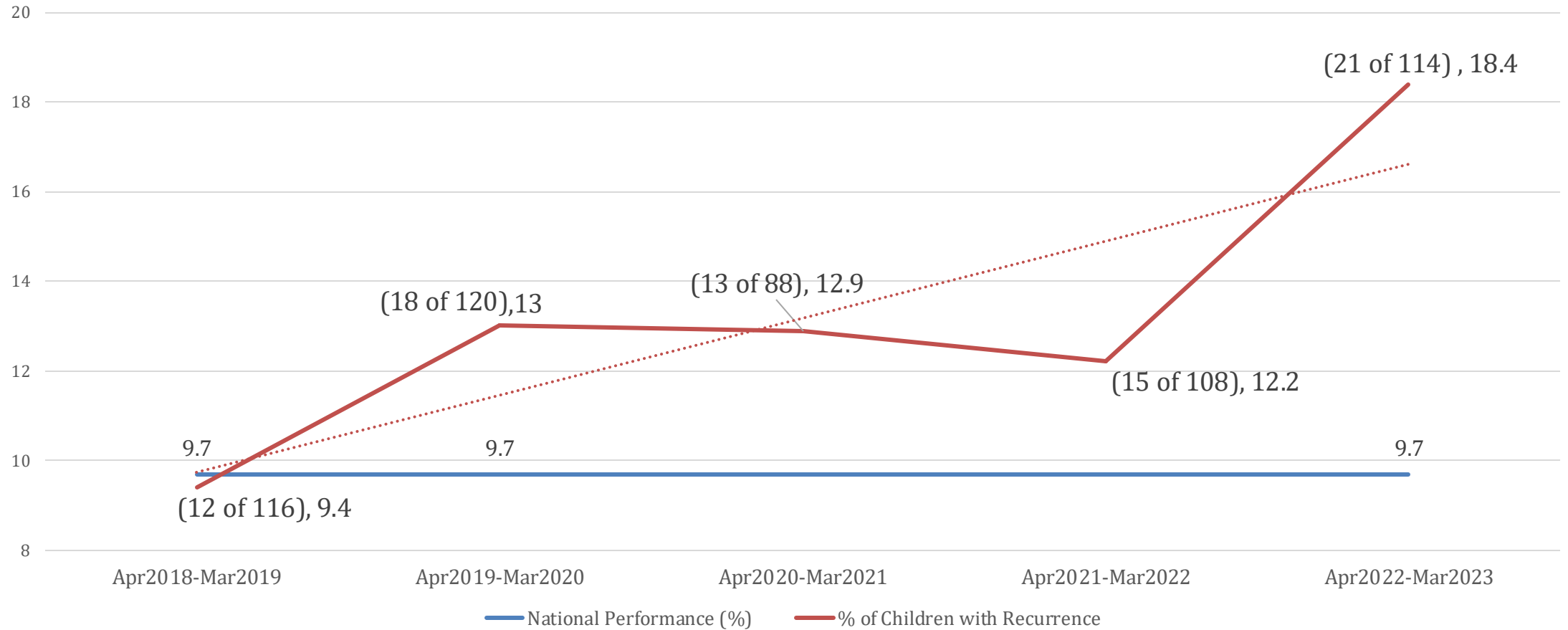
Child Welfare

- S-2 Recurrence of Maltreatment
 - *Of all children with a substantiated allegation during the 12-month period, what percent had another substantiated allegation within 12 months*
- P-1 Reunification in 12 Months (of entering foster care)
 - *Of all children who enter foster care in a 12-month period, what percent discharged to permanency within 12 months of entering foster care?*

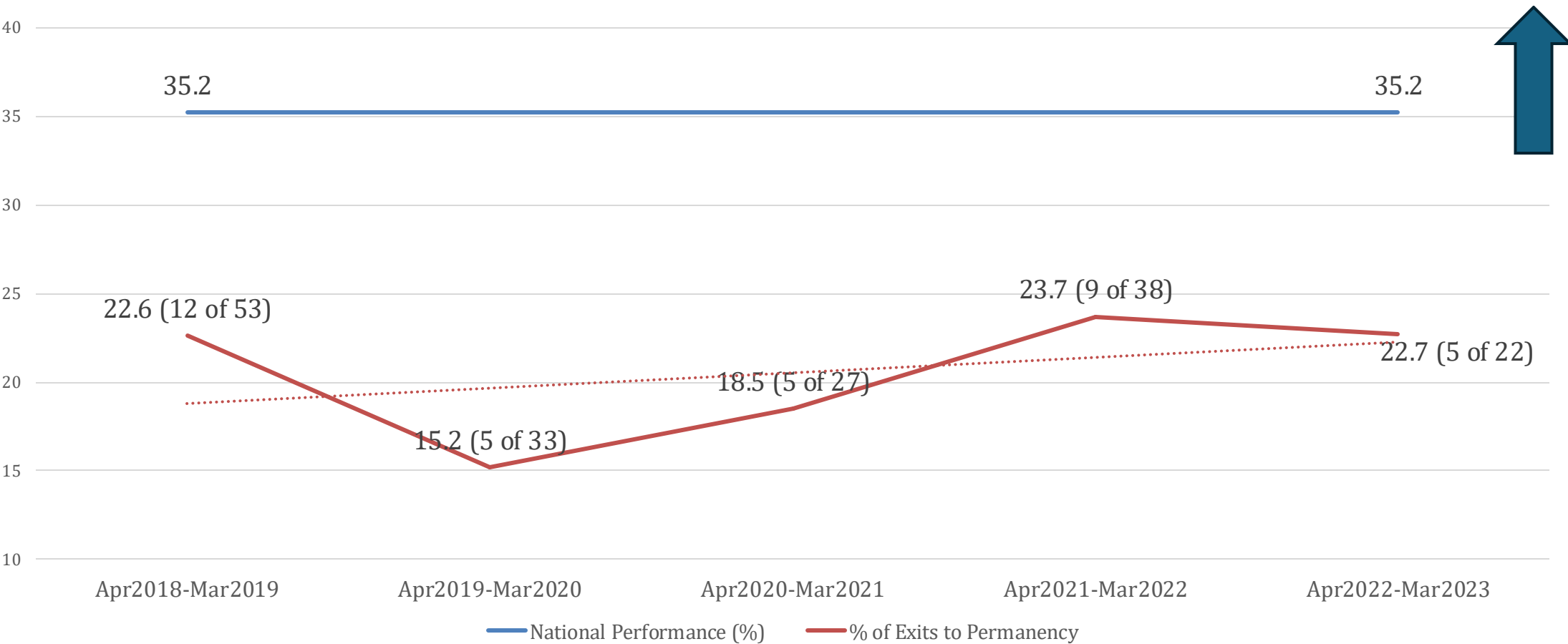

Child Welfare Strategy 1

- Implement a progressive visitation policy that supports families to ensure timely and safe reunification. Social workers will utilize the policy and Behaviorally Based Case Planning to increase parent engagement and consistently assess for safety and risk.



Child Welfare Strategy 2

- Strengthen emergency response protocols to ensure child safety by systematically reviewing recurrence referrals, maintaining compliance with Division 31 regulations, and utilizing SDM assessment tools.



Service Array

- Service Array is defined as the **capacity** to deliver a comprehensive service array that is available, accessible, and able to be individualized.

Probation Strategy 1

- Identify tribal leaders and advocates to establish working relationships to provide culturally competent services.
