- 1. July 4 (Independence Day)
- 2. First Monday in September (Labor Day)
- 3. Second Monday in October (Indigenous Peoples' Day)
- 4. November 11 (Veteran's Day)
- 5. Thanksgiving Day
- 6. Day after Thanksgiving Day
