1 **Summary**

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3 On 3/2/2020, I received information about the location of stolen equipment in Middletown, California. It was
4 learned during the course of the investigation the property had recently been sold and the new property
5 owners were planning on putting in a large marijuana grow. The new property owner, [REDACTED] stated
6 he hired a contractor to do work around the property. The contractor had the equipment delivered to the
7 property and left there. [REDACTED] a loss prevention investigator contracted with Herc Rental, contacted
8 Herc Rental employee, [REDACTED] about the stolen equipment's last known GPS location in Middletown
9 and requested he verify its location. [REDACTED] confirmed the equipment location was at 16750 Herrington
10 Rd from the public road and requested the Lake County Sheriff's office assist in recovering the equipment.
11 Lake County Sheriff's office referred the matter to Clear Lake CHP Sgt. Dye, while [REDACTED] contacted CHP
12 Northern Division ISU for assistance.

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14 *Investigators note: The address 16750 Herrington Rd is a private driveway off of Jaclyn Dr. in what is*
15 *known as the unincorporated town of Hidden Valley Lake, just north of Middletown, California.*

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17 On 3/3/20 at approximately 1330 hours, I received a copy of the CHP 180 stolen report receipt triplicate. In
18 the report the Livermore Police Department had a listed case number of 20-1369 for both the orange Kubota
19 "side by side" and the blue Gene "grade-all." The report was dated 2/27/20 at 2135 hours. The items listed
20 in the stolen report are as follows:

27 On 3/3/20, CHP ISU members and Clear Lake CHP officers, recovered the stolen equipment from 16750
28 Herrington Rd, Middletown, California. No additional equipment was located, and no one was arrested at
29 that time.
