ORDINANCE NO. _____
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1.1.A OF ORDINANCE NO. 2945
INCREASING THE CHARGES AND FEES FOR
COUNTY SERVICE AREA NO. 2 – SPRING VALLEY LAKES

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Lake ordains as follows:

Section 1: The following charges and fees for C.S.A. No. 2 are hereby approved and adopted:

1. Charges for Water Service

a.

- b. Standby Charges: \$6.00 per month
A service connection is eligible for standby rates if there is zero usage for four (4) or more months.
- c. Metered water service shall be billed every two months.
- d. Water hydrants:
 - (1) A charge of \$50.00 to set hydrant meter.
 - (2) A base charge of \$30.00 per month.
 - (3) A charge of \$2.75 for each 100 cubic feet per month.
 - (4) Charges for water hydrants shall be due upon receipt of billing.

2. Miscellaneous Charges.

- 1 a. Late Charge - A monthly late charge of 10% of any portion of bill that is past
2 due. Payment is considered past due when not received within 30 days
3 following the mailing of the notice that payment is due.
- 4 b. Lock Off and turn on charges:
- 5 (1) A charge of \$24.00 to shut off service made upon request of recipient of
6 service.
- 7 (2) A charge of \$24.00 to turn on service made upon request of recipient of
8 service.
- 9 (3) An additional charge of \$58.00 when the CSA is required to lock off
10 service because of the failure to pay charges.
- 11 c. Account setup charges:
12 A charge of \$24.00 each time an account is setup for ownership change or rental
13 contract.
- 14 d. Rental deposit - When service is made to property being rented or leased, the
15 tenant shall be required to complete a Renter's Contract and deposit \$92.00
16 with the County. The deposit made pursuant to this provision is refundable to
17 the depositor thereof, upon the complete payment by tenant of the closing
18 statement of charges, or when the tenant becomes legal owner of record,
19 whichever occurs first.
- 20 e. Cut locking device charge - A charge of \$125.00 each time a meter-locking
21 device is cut off by non-county personnel. This charge is in addition to any
22 costs to repair or replace damaged equipment.
- 23 f. Capital Improvement Program: Per SFD equivalent, \$7.20 per month

3. Line Connections

- 19 a. Metered line connections:
- 20 (1) A charge of \$797.00 for the installation of a water meter.
- 21 (2) A charge of \$400.00 for each additional meter installed on the same
22 property and at the same time.
- 23 (3) The cost for installation of a water meter and tap to the main line is as
24 follows:
- (A) A charge of \$800.00 for five-eighths by three-quarter inch meter.

(B) A charge of \$1,000 for one-inch meter.

- 1 (4) A charge based on the cost of material and labor shall be due for any
2 meters or meter and taps not covered by the provisions of subdivision
3 (1), (2), and (3) above. Any person or entity requesting the installation
4 of a meter pursuant to this subdivision shall deposit the amount of
5 \$1,000.00 with the County. In the event the total cost, as determined by
6 the County exceeds said deposit, the deposit shall be credited to the total
7 amount due for such costs. In the event the total costs is less than such
8 deposit, the difference between the deposit and the total cost shall be
9 refunded within a reasonable amount of time of the completion of work.

4. Capital Improvement Fee

- 9 a. There shall be fees for any new construction or addition to existing structures and
10 facilities in the following amount.

11 (1) Single Family Dwelling Equivalent \$19,217.00

- 12 b. When a specific connection type is not addressed, fees will be calculated on the flow
13 data provided in an approved capacity analysis.

14 Section 2: Charges and fees set forth in Paragraphs 3 and 4, shall be adjusted for
15 inflation on May 1st of every year. Beginning May 1, 2012, these charges will be
16 adjusted using the Engineering News Record-Construction index (ENR). In the event
17 of a negative index, no change in the water charges and fees shall be made.

18 Section 3: All ordinances or resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby
19 repealed to the extent of such conflict and no further.

20 Section 4: This ordinance shall take effect on the _____ day of
21 _____, 2024 and before the expiration of fifteen (15) days after its
22 passage, it shall be published at least once in a newspaper of general circulation printed
23 and published in the County of Lake.
