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RESOLUTION APPROVING THE EXTENSION FOR INCREASE IN PENALTIES ON SPECIFIC OFFENSES INCLUDING MOVING TRAFFIC VIOLATIONS BY TWO DOLLARS FOR EVERY TEN DOLLARS COLLECTED TO PROVIDE A SPECIFIC SHARE FOR EMERGENCY DEPARTMENTS APPROVED FOR PEDIATRICS AND ADDITIONAL FUNDING FOR MADDY FUND RECIPIENTS, INCLUDING NORTH COAST EMS TO **JANUARY 1, 2027** 

WHEREAS, the Lake County Board of Supervisors previously established the Emergency Medical Services (EMS) "MADDY" Fund for the deposit of certain penalty assessments collected pursuant to Section 1465 of the Penal Code, and authorized the specific allocation of all penalty assessment revenues to be distributed among certain funds, including the EMS Fund; and,

WHEREAS, Government Code Section 76000.5 as added by Chapter 841 of the Statutes of 2006 provides that the County may impose an additional penalty of two dollars (\$2) for every ten dollars (\$10) or fraction thereof, upon various fines, penalties and forfeitures collected by the courts for criminal offenses to be used to provide additional funds to the Fund; and

WHEREAS, Health and Safety Code Section 1797.98a as amended by Chapter 841 of the Statues of 2006 provides that of the money deposited into the EMS Fund pursuant to Section 76000.5 of the Government Code, fifteen percent (15%) shall be utilized to provide funding for all pediatric trauma centers throughout the County, both publicly and privately owned and operated, provided, however, that counties that do not maintain a pediatric trauma center shall utilize the money deposited into the Fund to improve access to, and coordination of, pediatric trauma and emergency services in the County, with preference given for funding to be given to hospitals that specialize in services to children, and physicians and surgeons who provide emergency care for children; and, that the costs of administering money deposited into the Fund pursuant shall be reimbursed from the money collected, not to exceed ten percent (10%).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED, that pursuant to Government Code section 76000.5, on , 2017 and thereafter, there shall be levied, in addition to the penalties prescribed by Government Code section 76000.5, an additional penalty assessment of two dollars (\$2) for every ten dollars (\$10) or fraction thereof, which shall be collected, together with and in the same manner as the amounts established by Section 1464 of the Penal Code, upon every fine, penalty, or forfeiture imposed and collected by the courts for criminal offenses, including violations of Division 9 (commencing with Section 23000) of the Business and Professions Code relating to the control of alcoholic beverages, and all offenses involving a violation of the Vehicle Code or any local ordinance adopted pursuant to the Vehicle Code, except parking offenses subject to Article 3 (commencing with Section 40200) of Chapter 1 of Division 17 of the Vehicle Code. Said additional money collected shall be taken from fines and forfeitures deposited with the County Treasurer prior to any divisions pursuant to Section 1463 of the Penal Code.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED, that all such additional assessments collected pursuant to Section 76000.5 of the Government Code shall be transferred to the County of Lake for deposit and account into the EMS "Maddy" Fund, and payments from the Emergency Medical Services Fund shall, in accordance with the requirements of Health and Safety Code section 1797.98a, et seq., after reimbursement of costs of administering the Fund, which amount shall not exceed ten percent (10%) of the money collected, be distributed as follows:

- A. The balance of the funds collected shall be distributed as follows:
  - 1. Fifty-eight percent (58%) to physicians and surgeons for emergency medical services provided by all physicians and surgeons in general acute care hospitals that provide basic or comprehensive emergency services up to the time the patient is stabilized.
  - 2. Twenty-five percent (25%) to hospitals providing disproportionate trauma and emergency medical care services.
  - 3. Seventeen percent (17%) for other emergency medical services purposes to the North Coast Emergency Medical Services Agency to administer the EMS System.
- B. Of the total additional assessment amount collected, reduced by the amount for administration, fifteen percent (15%) shall be distributed to North Coast EMS to improve access to, and coordination of, pediatric trauma and emergency services in the County, with preference given to funding for designated Emergency Departments Approved for Pediatrics (EDAPs). Funds spent for this purpose shall be known as Richie's Fund, which shall remain in effect only until January 1, 2027, and shall have no force or effect on or after the date, unless a later enacted statute, that is chaptered before January 1, 2027, deletes or extends that date.
