<u>Side Letter Agreement with the Lake County Deputy Sheriff Association (LCDSA) Unit</u> <u>16 Regarding Amendment to the October 21, 2021 – June 30, 2025 MOU.</u>

The County wishes to add Juneteenth as a County Declared Holiday. To achieve this, the County and LCDSA agree that effective December 6, 2022, Section 4.5.1 Holidays Defined of the LCDSA October 21, 2021 – June 30, 2025 MOU, or any successor agreement, shall be adjusted as follows:

4.5 COUNTY DECLARED HOLIDAYS

4.5.1 Holidays Defined

The following days during the contractual period shall be declared as holidays for unit members:

January 1st
Third Monday in January
Third Monday in February
Last Monday in May
June 19 th
July 4th
First Monday in September
Second Monday in October
November 11 th
Fourth Thursday in November
Friday following the Fourth Thursday in November
Monday – Friday of the week December 25 th falls on, if December 25 th falls on a weekday. If December 25 th falls on a Saturday or Sunday, the 23 rd through the 29 th of December.

This side letter shall apply to the current MOU and any successor agreements and shall continue until such time as either:

- 1) A successor MOU is ratified by both the County and LCDSA; or
- 2) The County and LCDSA agree to amend the applicable sections of the current MOU, whichever is sooner.
