**WHEREAS**, Raymond Ruminski has been commended many times during his tenure for his mentorship and guidance, calm commitment, willingness and ability to work with the public, contractors, County departments, and many community members to solve seemingly un-solvable problems; and

**WHEREAS**, During the Rocky, Jerusalem, Valley, Clayton and Sulphur fires, Raymond Ruminski was instrumental in working with the State and Federal government, dedicating many hours of help and encouragement to the communities and the many citizens impacted throughout the debris cleanup and recovery process; and

**WHEREAS**, Raymond Ruminski's outstanding performance, superior dedication and extraordinary contributions ranging from pulling a tooth in the lobby for a small child to solving problems in the field have served as an excellent example to those under his leadership and throughout the community over the years. As Raymond retires, the staff of the Lake County Health Services Department applaud him. He will be greatly missed.
