REQUEST FOR GRANT FUNDS FOR PURCHASE OF NEW PATROL BOAT

The Lake County Sheriff's Office respectfully requests to be considered for a grant for the purchase of a new patrol boat.

The primary lake the Sheriff's Office patrols is Clear Lake. Clear Lake is the largest natural fresh water lake entirely within the State of California. Clear Lake is so large that it often produces similar characteristics to that of the ocean. The lake is busy with boaters most of the year. There are bass fishing tournaments nearly every weekend of the year. There are boat races and also an annual sea plane fly in that attract numerous amphibious aircraft.

The Lake County Sheriff's Office Marine Patrol Unit consists of one full time Sergeant and five seasonal Deputies. At this current time the unit has four primary patrol vessels that are serviceable. Three of our primary vessels have more than 5300 hours of service on them. These vessels have been problematic because of their age.

In February of 2018 the Lake County Sheriff's Office surveyed the 1984 Boston Whaler, center console style patrol boat, CF 2077 XC. This patrol boat had been problematic because of its age. The vessel was in for repairs several times in the early part of last season. The vessel had several fuel leaks and was put out of service for safety reasons by the State Inspector. Because of the lack of patrol vessel's we had to borrow Mendocino County Sheriff Department's patrol vessel for the summer season. This vessel was returned to the Mendocino County Sheriff Department at the end of the 2017 summer season.

In addition to surveying the 1984 Boston Whaler, CF 2077 XC, we had another primary patrol vessel, a 2003 Design Concepts CF 4441XC, have a major motor failure. We will also be requesting to survey this vessel in the near future. The vessel has always performed poorly as its hull design does not allow it to plain correctly. This can be a major issue when navigating Clear Lake during rough conditions that our lake frequently produces.

During the 2017/2018 fiscal year our 2000 Jet Craft, CF 4079 XC, had a major transom failure. The state inspector requested we repower the vessel instead of trying to repair it. I submitted a grant for the repairs, but unfortunately it was declined. This patrol boat in currently non operational.

Based on the surveying of the 1984 Boston Whaler, CF 2077 XC, and having two other primary vessels inoperable, we believe the need for an additional patrol boat is warranted.

If approved the grant funds would be used to replace the 1984 Boston Whaler, CF 2077 XC. Thank you in advance for your consideration and if you should have any questions, please feel free to contact me.

The Lake County Sheriff's Department's has had a Boating Safety program for over 30 years. Our unit currently consists of one full time Sergeant and five seasonal Deputies. Our enforcement activities and very broad as we patrol several lakes

in Lake County. The primary lake that we patrol is Clear Lake, which is the largest natural lake fully within the borders of California. Clear Lake has over one hundred miles of shore line with several public launch areas and over 1000 private docks and boat slips.

Our unit teaches boating safety classes and instructs an annual Lake County Sheriff's citizen's academy. We do general waterway patrol and enforcement of the California Penal Code, Harbors and Navigation Code and local ordinances related to boating. We do several vessel checks for violations along with checks for Quagga mussel violations. Much of our time is spent performing boating inspections, investigating boating accidents and conducting search and rescue operations.

There are several large events on Clear Lake during the summer months. Some of these event are short track boat races, an annual seaplane fly in and more the fifty bass fishing tournaments. There is also an annual two day catfishing tournament that brings in over 500 vessels to Clear Lake. Our unit is involved in the planning and safety of many of these events. This give our Deputies several opportunities to interact with the public.

This program is an essential part of the Sheriff's Department's commitment to securing the public's trust and providing assistance to the boating public. It has and continues to be very well received by local residents and visitors alike.

To whom it may concern:

Thank you for the opportunity to bid on your lake patrol boat.

We have bid our Rogue Jet "Coastal" model of boat. This is the same hull we have built patrol boats for Napa County Sheriff (3), Tuolumne County, Lake Piru, Lake Casitas, Placer County Sheriff, U.S. Fish and Wildlife in Lodi, and numerous other counties.

The "Coastal" model will be 23' in length with a 102" beam, 78" bottom width, and 1/4" (.250") thickness bottom. You had specified 3/16" bottom but in this size of boat with the large engine it should be the thicker bottom as we have bid.

We do a full welded large box girder longitudinal construction under the floor which is stronger than the small longitudinal construction you specified.

We use a 3" "D" rubber bumper on the sides of the boat rather than the 2" you specified.

We incorporate our radar arch into the welded frame top rather than another arch over top of the welded frame top.

We build our own custom welded "aluminum" trailer custom built to the boat rather than the mass produced bolt together trailers.

Any of your local marine repair facilities can do warranty work. We want to be notified prior to work to instruct on proper repair. The Mercury outboard engine of course needs an authorized Mercury repair center.




