**RESOLUTION ADOPTING A LIST OF PROJECTS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2023-24 FUNDED BY  
SB 1: THE ROAD REPAIR AND ACCOUNTABILITY ACT OF 2017**

**WHEREAS**, Senate Bill 1 (SB 1), the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017 (Chapter 5, Statutes of 2017) was passed by the Legislature and Signed into law by the Governor in April 2017 to address the significant multi-modal transportation funding shortfalls statewide; and

**WHEREAS**, SB 1 includes accountability and transparency provisions that will ensure the residents of our County are aware of the projects proposed for funding in our community and which projects have been completed each fiscal year; and

**WHEREAS**, Pursuant to SHC Section 2034(a)(1), this project list shall not limit the flexibility of an eligible county to fund projects in accordance with local needs and priorities, so long as the projects are consistent with SHC Section 2030(b). After submittal of the project list to the Commission, in the event a county elects to make changes to the project list pursuant to the statutory provision noted above, formal notification of the Commission is not required; and

**WHEREAS**, the County must adopt by resolution a list of projects proposed to receive fiscal year funding from the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA), created by SB 1, which must include a description and the location of each proposed project, a proposed schedule for the project's completion, and the estimated useful life of the improvement; and

**WHEREAS**, the County, will receive an estimated \$3,537,375 in RMRA funding in Fiscal Year 2023-24 from SB 1; and

**WHEREAS**, this is the 7th year in which the County is receiving SB 1 funding and will enable the County to continue essential road maintenance and rehabilitation projects, safety improvements, repairing and replacing aging bridges, and increasing access and mobility options for the traveling public that would not have otherwise been possible without SB 1; and

**WHEREAS**, the County has undergone a robust public process to ensure public input into our community's transportation priorities/the project list; and

**WHEREAS**, the County used a Pavement Management System to develop the SB 1 project list to ensure revenues are being used on the most high-priority and cost-effective projects that also meet the communities priorities for transportation investment; and

**WHEREAS**, the funding from SB 1 will help the County maintain and rehabilitate three miles of road throughout the County this year and 15-20 miles of similar projects into the future; and

**WHEREAS**, the 2018 California Statewide Local Streets and Roads Needs Assessment found that the County's streets and roads are in a "poor" condition and this revenue will help us increase the overall quality of our road system; and

**WHEREAS**, the SB 1 project list and overall investment in our local streets and roads infrastructure with a focus on basic maintenance and safety, investing in complete streets infrastructure, and using cutting-edge technology, materials and practices, will have significant positive benefits throughout the County.

**NOW, THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, ORDERED AND FOUND** by the Board of Supervisors, State of California, as follows:

1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct.
2. The following previously proposed and adopted projects may also utilize Fiscal Year 2023-24 Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account revenues in their delivery. With the relisting of these projects in the adopted fiscal year resolution, the County is reaffirming to the public and the State our intent to fund these projects with Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account revenues: see attached list in Exhibit A.
