### Public Works Road Division

- 37 miles of chip sealing Lower Lake / Kelseyville

### 2024 Pavement Rehabilitation Project

- 16 miles of pavement rehabilitation in Cobb Area

### Kelseyville Sidewalk Project

- 1/3 miles of sidewalk near Kelseyville High School

### Dynamic Variable Speed Feedback Signs

- 11 locations throughout the County

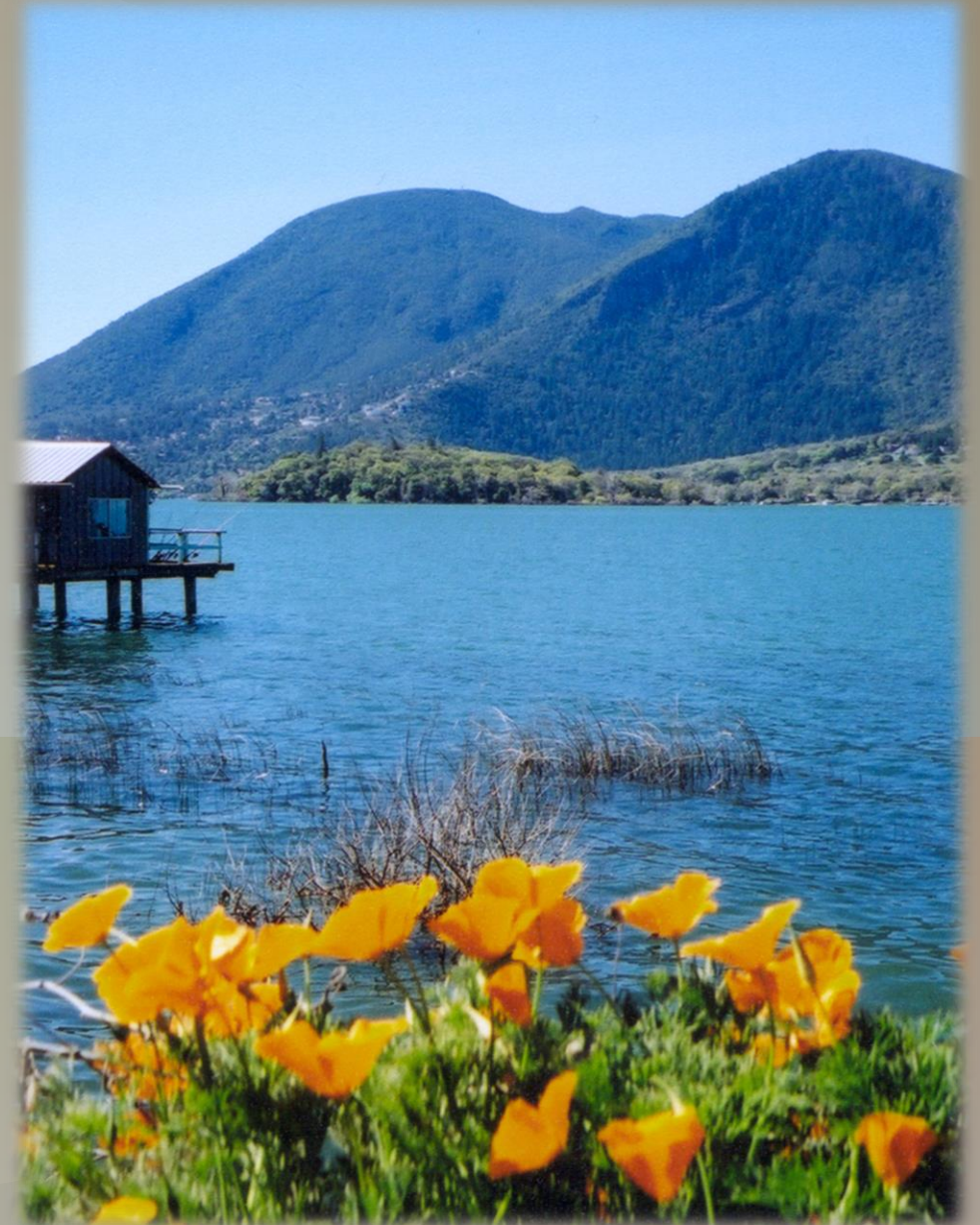

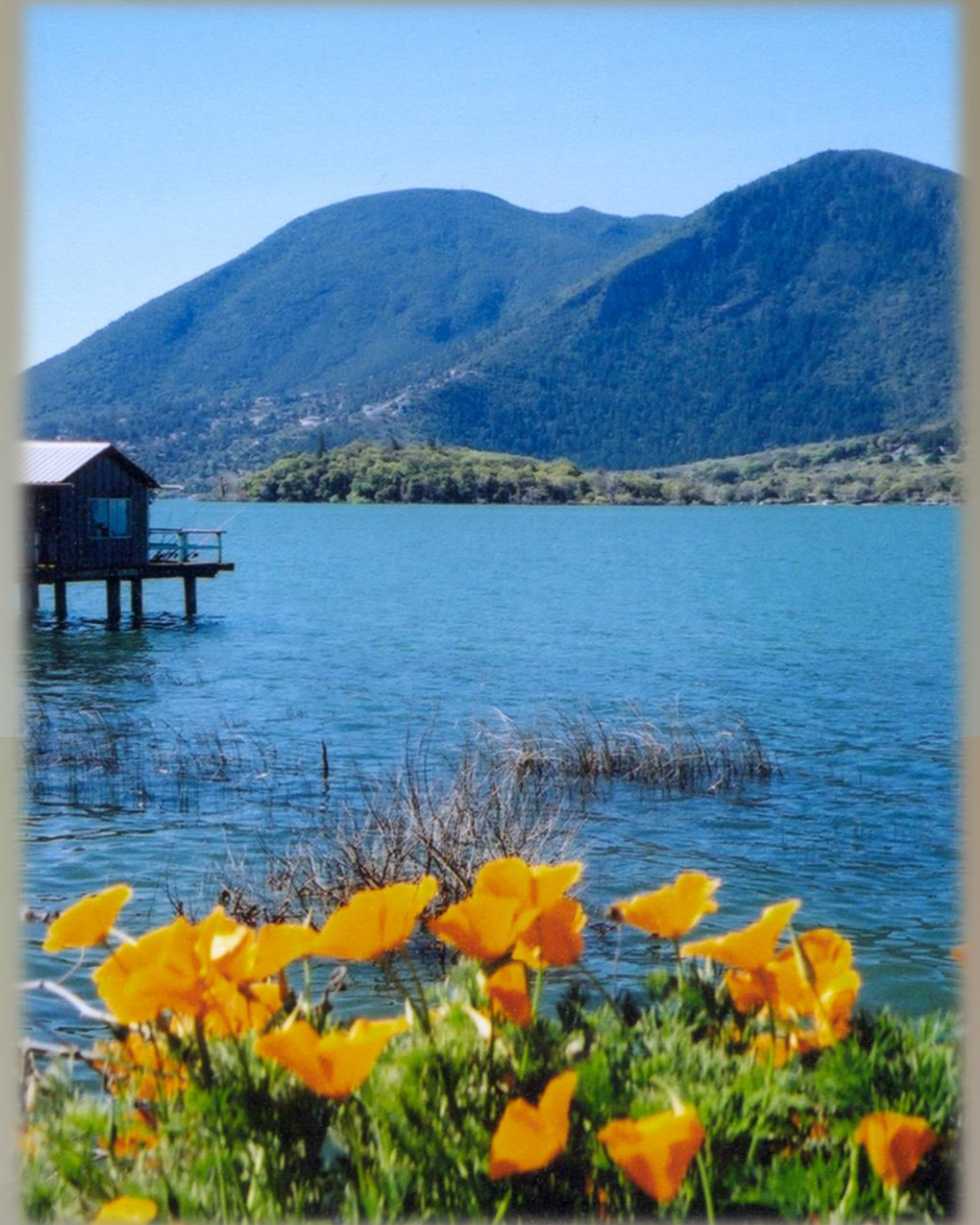
