DESIGNATING MAY 15, 2026, AS NATIONAL
PEACE OFFICERS' MEMORIAL DAY AND THE WEEK OF
MAY 10-16, 2026, AS NATIONAL POLICE WEEK IN LAKE COUNTY

WHEREAS, the dedicated men and women who have chosen law enforcement as a career face extraordinary risk and danger in preserving our freedom and security; and

WHEREAS, during the week of May 10-16, 2026, National Police Week is observed throughout the nation to recognize the hazardous work, serious responsibilities, and our strong commitment to our nation's peace officers; and

WHEREAS, in conjunction with that important observance, May 15 will be recognized as National Peace Officers' Memorial Day in commemoration of those noble officers who have tragically sacrificed their lives in the line-of-duty; and

WHEREAS, these special observances provide all Californians with the opportunity to appreciate the heroic men and women who have dedicated their lives to preserving public safety.

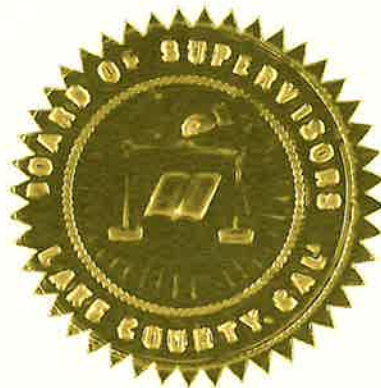
