3                   **AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2-3A.1 OF ARTICLE I, CHAPTER 2 OF THE**  
4                   **LAKE COUNTY CODE, COMPENSATION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS**

5                   WHEREAS, Lake County Code section 2-3A.1, establishes, commencing July 1, 2003, each  
6 member of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Lake shall receive as an annual salary for services  
7 rendered by law and by virtue of each of the offices, a sum equal to 60% of the average of the annual  
8 salaries of the District Attorney, Sheriff, Assessor, Auditor/Controller and Treasurer/Tax Collector, all  
9 elected County officials; and

10                   WHEREAS, this Board finds it is necessary to amend Section 2-3A.1, only, of Article I, Chapter  
11 2 of the Lake County Code, to fix annual salaries for members of the Lake County Board of Supervisors  
12 at the present amount, unless otherwise acted on by Ordinance.

13                   NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Lake ordains as follows:

14                   **Section 1:** The Board of Supervisors of the County of Lake hereby amends section 2-3A.1 of  
15 Article I, Chapter 2 of the Lake County Code to read as follows:

16                   Sec. 2-3A. – Compensation of the Board of Supervisors.

17                                   3A.1 Salary.

18                                   (a) Each member of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Lake shall receive as an  
19                                   annual salary for services rendered by law and by virtue of each of their offices, a  
20                                   sum of \$63,714.

21                                   (b) In addition to the foregoing annual salary, the Chair of the Board shall receive  
22                                   additional annual compensation in the amount of two thousand, four hundred  
23                                   dollars (\$2,400.00).

24                   **Section 2:** It can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility this Ordinance may have a  
25 significant effect on the environment.

26                   **Section 3:** All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances or Resolutions or parts of Resolutions in  
27 conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict and no further.

28                   **Section 4:** This ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after its passage. Before the  
29 expiration of fifteen (15) days after passage of this ordinance, it shall be published at least once with the  
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1 names of the members of the Board of Supervisors voting for an against the ordinance in a newspaper of  
2 general circulation published in the County of Lake, State of California.
