5 RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ACCESS TO STATE, LOCAL AND FEDERAL CRIMINAL
6 HISTORY INFORMATION BY THE COUNTY OF LAKE

8 WHEREAS, Penal Code Sections 11105(b)(11) and 13300(b)(11)
9 authorize cities, counties, districts and joint powers authorities to access state
10 and local summary criminal history information for employment, licensing or
11 certification purposes; and

12 WHEREAS, Penal Code Section 11105(b)(11) authorizes cities, counties,
13 districts, and joint powers to access federal level criminal history information by
14 transmitting fingerprint images and related information to the Department of
15 Justice to be transmitted to the Federal Bureau of Investigation; and

16 WHEREAS, Penal Code Sections 11105(b)(11) and 13300(b)(11) require
17 that there be a requirement or exclusion from employment, licensing, or
18 certification based on specific criminal conduct on the part of the subject of the
19 record; and

20 WHEREAS, Penal Code Sections 11105(b)(11) and 13300(b)(11) require
21 the city council, board of supervisors, governing body of a city, county or district
22 or joint powers authority to specifically authorize access to summary criminal
23 history information for employment, licensing, or certification purposes.

24 WHEREAS, the public confidence in the work of the County of Lake can
25 be most effectively maintained by ensuring that the criminal histories of
26 employees are properly screened; and

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WHEREAS, requiring that the criminal histories of all County of Lake employment applicants be screened prior to employment and upon applying for promotion, or gaining access to sensitive personal information is consistent with the aforementioned code sections.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the County of Lake is hereby authorized to access state and federal level summary criminal history information, and subsequent arrest notifications for employment (including volunteers and contract employees), licensing, or certification purposes within the County of Lake and may not disseminate the information to a private entity.
