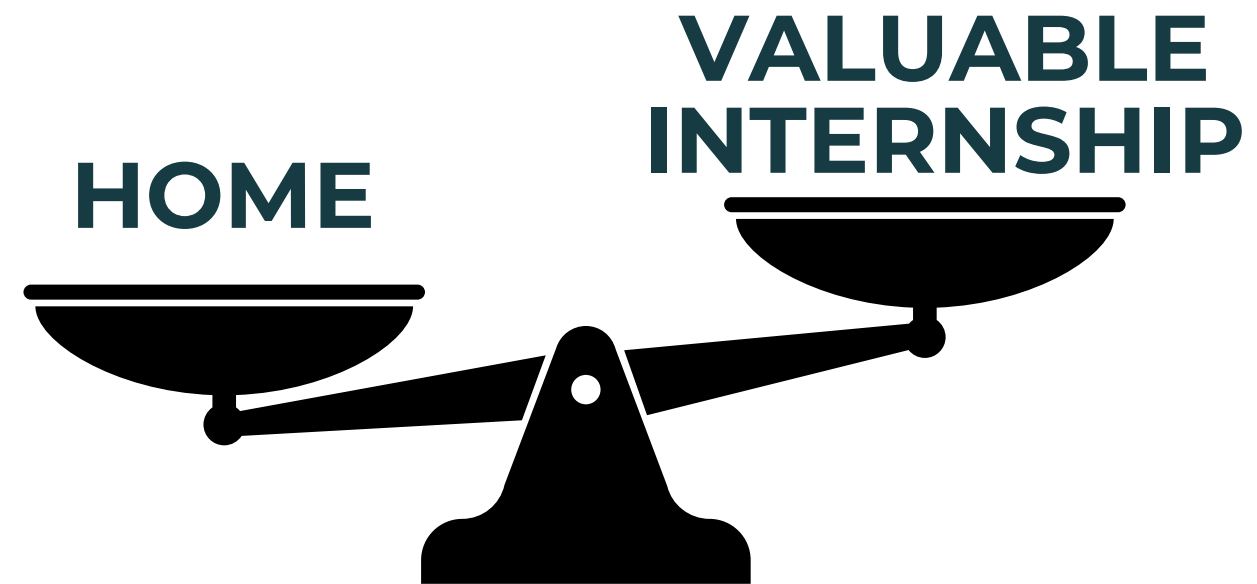

Colors Matter

- Top Flyer: Looks fine but uses random colors. Doesn't feel like Lake County Parks and Rec.
- Bottom Flyer: Uses our approved palette. Feels cohesive, recognizable, and true to our brand.

Why Colors Matter:

Color is one of the fastest ways people recognize a brand. If every park flyer, Facebook post, or banner uses a different set of colors, the public won't make the connection that it all belongs to Lake County Parks and Recreation. By sticking to our palette, we make every piece of communication part of the same story.

Instruction:

When designing, especially in Canva or other template tools, staff must be particular about color choices. Do not grab whatever looks "nice" or "bright." Use the approved hex codes and keep them consistent across flyers, posts, and signs. This discipline is what builds a recognizable brand over time.

Montserrat -->

Lake County

Montserrat Bold is great for titles and headers. It is modern, strong, and widely used in professional, government and non-profit branding. It is authoritative without being stiff.

Lato -->

LATO. Extremely readable, even at small sizes making it good for text on print, and online. Neutral enough to fit modern or retro campaign styles and partners with Montserrat Bold to create a "professional parks department" look that is consistent with other California County Branding.

Roller Coaster Serif -->

LAKE COUNTY Community Park

Roller Coaster Serif is great for main titles and event names. First line all caps, second line lower case with yellow fill and red shadow on the right. This is the anchor font for retro campaigns and should always be used for the top line

Futura -->

FUTURA medium or regular is for sub-headers and main information. It works best in shorter blocks, bullet points of key details

Bitter -->

BITTER is more of a stylistic body for busier fliers or posts, use when an extra spark is needed or for a nostalgic quote or small section. Can give a much more traditional, retro feel but can also clash with the title.

Lato -->

LATO is good for when the text gets even smaller. Fine print, disclaimers, or additional notes that need to stay readable at small sizes. It keeps the retro theme clean and legible without taking attention away from the big fonts.

Playlist Script -->

PLAYLIST SCRIPT is a brush-style script, bold and stylish, with a little grit. Feels more vintage poster than cute, so it holds its own in retro layouts. Works well for emphasis words like "Summer Nights" or "Live Music." Risk: can get hard to read if used in long words or small sizes.
