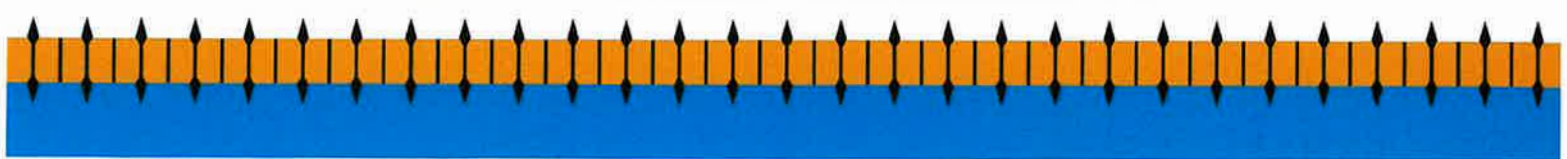

I'm assisting the cannabis team with some applications. The project "UP 21-07", Little High Valley Road, is apparently within your area of interest according to a 2021 email received by the County.

This application has gone through four or five planners, and I don't see anything that says that a consultation was held on this one.

I don't think the CEQA documents were uploaded to the State Clearinghouse; I searched back to Jan. 1, 2021 – the application was submitted to the County on Feb. 10, 2021.

Let me know if you still want to hold Consultation and I will schedule it. Also, some Tribes like to have the applicant present – if this is what you want, please let me know, otherwise I'll just invite you assuming you still want to hold consultation of course.
