3 **A RESOLUTION OF OPPOSITION TO AB 1250**

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5 WHEREAS, the Lake County Board of Supervisors registered opposition to AB 1250 on June
6 20, 2017, on the basis it would impose a de facto prohibition on our county's ability to contract with non-
7 profits that are licensed experts and community based organizations who deliver vital services to our
8 residents; and

9 WHEREAS, AB 1250 would establish contract procurement and renewal requirements of 57 of
10 California's 58 counties that apply to no other state or local agency in California, severely threatening
11 services to some of Lake County's most vulnerable individuals; and

12 WHEREAS, recent amendments of September 5 fail to address concerns that AB 1250 will
13 undermine County contracting authority without further the bill's stated intent to enhance transparency
14 and accountability; and

15 WHEREAS, health, mental, and behavioral health, public safety, housing and emergency
16 response services are among those most vital and most likely to be compromised by AB 1250, as
17 written; and

18 WHEREAS, the County of Lake continues to suffer reverberations from the effects of several
19 recent disasters, including 2015's Valley Fire, and contracting for many services has been vital to our
20 ongoing recovery effort; and

21 WHEREAS, contracting for services is often the best available avenue to maximize effective
22 use of resources and taxpayer dollars, which is critically important in the face of the broad-based
23 economic challenges the County of Lake is facing, and AB 1250 threatens to critically threaten many
24 key opportunities; and

25 WHEREAS, AB 1250 has progressed through the State legislature in spite of widespread
26 opposition from County governments, who are best positioned to appreciate the impact of government
27 contracts upon their communities, as a whole.

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3 NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Lake resolves as follows:
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5 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF LAKE, STATE**
6 **OF CALIFORNIA**, that the County of Lake urges Assemblymember Cecilia Aguiar-Curry, State Senator
7 Mike McGuire, and all California State legislators, to strongly oppose AB 1250. Given broad-based
8 opposition from Counties to this legislation, and the considerable interruptions and/or eliminations of
9 public services that are likely to result, the cost of AB 1250 is too great. If accountability is the intent of
10 this legislation, as has been stated, let a bill be crafted that provides appropriate oversight without
11 impacting delivery of critical services to some of California's most vulnerable persons.
