RESOLUTION EXPRESSING SUPPORT FOR LOWER LAKE PARADE
AND STREET FAIR, AND TEMPORARILY AUTHORIZING A ROAD CLOSURE,
PROHIBITING PARKING AND AUTHORIZING REMOVAL OF VEHICLES AND ORDERING
THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS TO POST SIGNS

WHEREAS, the Lower Lake Community Action Group has scheduled the Lower Lake Parade and Street Fair to be held from 7:00 AM through 5:00 PM on May 24, 2026; and

WHEREAS, as part of this Lower Lake community activity, a parade, pet parade, and street fair have been scheduled; and

WHEREAS, historically, the Lower Lake Community Action Group has donated all proceeds from this annual event to local high schools and other civic organizations; and

WHEREAS, this event being held on May 24, 2026, will require the closure of Main Street at State Hwy 29/53, as well as various County maintained roadways; and

WHEREAS, IT IS THE UNDERSTANDING OF THE Board of Supervisors that the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) has requested confirmation of the Board's support for the Lower Lake Daze Parade and Street Fair; and

WHEREAS, Section 21101, subdivision (e) of the Vehicle Code authorizes the Board to temporarily close a portion of any street where signs are posted giving notice of the closure; and

WHEREAS, Section 22651, subdivision (n) of the Vehicle Code, authorizes this Board to prohibit parking and the removal of vehicles where signs are posted giving notice of the removal.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Lake does hereby find, determine, resolve and order as follows

1. The Board of Supervisors of the County of Lake does hereby express support for the Lower Lake Daze Parade and Street Fair to be held May 24, 2026
2. No person shall operate any vehicle in the following locations from 7:00 a.m. through 4:00 p.m. on May 24, 2026:
 - (a) Main Street, County Road No. 140D from its intersection with the East side of State Highway 29/state Highway 53 to its intersection with the East side of Mill Street, County Road No. 141.

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- (b) Lake Street, County Road No. 141D from its intersection with Second Street, County Road No. 141B to its intersection with Main Street, County Road No. 140D
 - (c) Adams Street, County Road No. 141C from its intersection with Second Street, County Road No. 141B to its intersection with Main Street, County Road No. 140D.
 - (d) Mill Street, County Road No. 141 from its intersection with Second Street, County Road No. 141B to its intersection with Main Street, County Road No. 140D.
3. No person shall park any vehicle in the following locations from 7:00 a.m. through 5:00 p.m. on May 24, 2026:
- (a) Main Street, County Road No. 140D from its intersection with the East side of State Highway 29/state Highway 53 to its intersection with the East side of Mill Street, County Road No. 141.
 - (b) Lake Street, County Road No. 141D from its intersection with Second Street, County Road No. 141B to its intersection with Main Street, County Road No. 140D.
 - (c) Adams Street, County Road No. 141C from its intersection with Second Street, County Road No. 141B to its intersection with Main Street, County Road No. 140D
 - (d) Mill Street, County Road No. 141 from its intersection with Second Street, County Road No. 141B to its intersection with Main Street, County Road No. 140D
4. All vehicles parked in violation of this Resolution may be removed as provided by law.
5. The Department of Public Works or their designate, shall post signs giving notice of the removal as provided in Section 22651, subdivision (n), of the Vehicle Code.
