AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 19-17.2 OF THE
ORDINANCE CODE OF THE COUNTY OF LAKE FOR THE
REMOVAL OF A STOP SIGN ON SECOND STREET AND THE
PLACEMENT OF A STOP SIGN ON MIDDLE CREEK ROAD IN UPPER LAKE

1 **WHEREAS**, The County of Lake has jurisdiction over Second Street and Middle Creek
2 Road as public highways within the unincorporated area of Upper Lake in Lake County; and

3 **WHEREAS**, California Vehicle Code Section 22450(c) authorizes local authorities to
4 establish stop intersections and provide for the placement of stop signs on highways under their
5 jurisdiction where such traffic control would enhance traffic safety; and

6 **WHEREAS**, The Department of Public Works has evaluated traffic operations, roadway
7 characteristics, sight distance, traffic volumes, collision history, and other relevant engineering
8 factors at the intersection of Second Street and Middle Creek Road; and

9 **WHEREAS**, based upon that evaluation, the Department of Public Works has determined
10 that installation of a stop sign requiring traffic on Middle Creek Road to stop before entering the
11 intersection with Second Street would improve traffic safety and promote the orderly movement of
12 traffic; and

13 **WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors finds that establishment of stop control at this
14 location is necessary and appropriate for the protection of the public health, safety, and welfare.

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**NOW THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF
LAKE ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:**

Section One: Subsection (on) of Section 17.2 of Chapter 19 of the Lake County Code is hereby
replaced with the following:

"(on) On Middle Creek Road, Upper Lake, County Road No. 311A, at its intersection with
Second Street, County Road No. 311, directing southbound traffic on Middle Creek Road to
stop."

Section Two: All ordinances or parts of ordinances or resolutions or part of resolutions in conflict
herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict and no further.

Section Three: This Ordinance shall take effect on the _____ day of _____,
2026, and before the expiration of fifteen days after its passage, it shall be published at least once in a
newspaper of general circulation in the County of Lake.
