**PROCLAMATION**

DESIGNATING THE WEEK OF APRIL 14-20, 2024  
AS NATIONAL PUBLIC SAFETY DISPATCHERS WEEK

**WHEREAS**, emergencies can occur at any time that require law enforcement, fire or emergency medical services; and

**WHEREAS**, when an emergency occurs, the prompt response of law enforcement officers, firefighters and emergency medical professionals is critical to the protection of life and preservation of property; and

**WHEREAS**, the safety of our law enforcement officers and fire personnel is dependent upon the quality and accuracy of information obtained from citizens who contact the Lake County Central Dispatch Center; and

**WHEREAS**, Public Safety Dispatchers are the first, and can be the most critical, contact our citizens have with emergency services, and provide the vital link for our law enforcement officers and fire personnel by monitoring their activities by radio, providing them with information, and ensuring their safety; and

**WHEREAS**, the Public Safety Dispatchers of the Lake County Sheriff's Office have contributed substantially to the apprehension of criminals, suppression of fires, treatment of patients, by exhibiting compassion, understanding, and professionalism during the performance of their job.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED** that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Lake does, hereby designate the week of April 14-20, 2024, as National Public Safety Dispatchers Week in Lake County and encourages all citizens to join in recognizing the commitment of public safety dispatchers in our communities to preserve the safety of us all.
