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## RESOLUTION ADOPTING A LIST OF PROJECTS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2024-25 FUNDED BY SB 1: THE ROAD REPAIR AND ACCOUNTABILITY ACT OF 2017

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 1 (SB 1), the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017 (Chapter 5, Statutes of 2017) was passed by the Legislature and Signed into law by the Governor in April 2017 to address the significant multi-modal transportation funding shortfalls statewide; and

WHEREAS, SB 1 includes accountability and transparency provisions that will ensure the residents of our County are aware of the projects proposed for funding in our community and which projects have been completed each fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to SHC Section 2034(a)(1), this project list shall not limit the flexibility of an eligible county to fund projects in accordance with local needs and priorities, so long as the projects are consistent with SHC Section 2030(b). After submittal of the project list to the Commission, in the event a county elects to make changes to the project list pursuant to the statutory provision noted above, formal notification of the Commission is not required; and

WHEREAS, the County must adopt by resolution a list of projects proposed to receive fiscal year funding from the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA), created by SB 1, which must include a description and the location of each proposed project, a proposed schedule for the project's completion, and the estimated useful life of the improvement; and

WHEREAS, the County, will receive an estimated \$3,666,818 in RMRA funding in Fiscal Year 2024-25 from SB 1; and

**WHEREAS**, this is the 8<sup>th</sup> year in which the County is receiving SB 1 funding and will enable the County to continue essential road maintenance and rehabilitation projects, safety improvements, repairing and replacing aging bridges, and increasing access and mobility options for the traveling public that would not have otherwise been possible without SB 1; and

WHEREAS, the County has undergone public process to ensure public input into our community's transportation priorities/the project list including public meetings to review various plans developed through the Area Planning Council and Board of Supervisors meetings to review the 10-year Pavement Rehabilitation Plan; and

WHEREAS, the County used a Pavement Management System to develop the SB 1 project list to ensure revenues are being used on the most high-priority and cost-effective projects that also meet the communities priorities for transportation investment; and

WHEREAS, the funding from SB 1 will help the County maintain and rehabilitate approximately 60 streets/roads, 2 bridges, and add approximately 2600 LF of pedestrian improvements throughout the County this year and at least 9 similar projects into the future; and

WHEREAS, the 2022 Lake County Pavement Management Program Update found that the County's overall pavement network is in "poor" condition and this revenue will help us increase the overall quality of our road system and over the next decade will bring our streets and roads into a "good" condition; and

WHEREAS, the SB 1 project list and overall investment in our local streets and roads infrastructure with a focus on basic maintenance and safety, investing in complete streets infrastructure, and using cutting-edge technology, materials and practices, will have significant positive co-benefits throughout the County; and

WHEREAS, the improvement of the County road network was a top priority of the public and completing those improvements is in accordance with the goals of the County's Vision 2028 policy

**NOW, THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, ORDERED AND FOUND** by the Board of Supervisors State of California, as follows:

- 1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct.
- 2. The following list of newly proposed projects will be funded in-part or solely with Fiscal Year 2024-25 Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account revenues: see attached list on Exhibit A.
- 3. The following previously proposed and adopted projects as shown on the attached Exhibit B may also utilize Fiscal Year 2024-25 Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account revenues in their delivery. With the relisting of these projects in the adopted fiscal year resolution, the County is reaffirming to the public and the State our intent to fund these projects with Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account revenues.
