#### H.R. 1 – Reconciliation Bill

#### **Opportunity Zones**

- Now permanent decennial designation
- Step-up-in basis 3x advantage for rural OZs
   30% versus 10%
- Cutting the "substantial improvement" requirement in half for investments in rural areas
- Governor Office decides next designations and taking effect in 2027

**AB 130** 

CEQA Exemption for Certain Housing Developments

Incorporated Areas or Census Urban Areas

Excludes Parcels in Very High Fire Hazard Severity Zones

**SB 131** 

CEQA Exemption for Certain Types of Development Projects

Health Centers and Rural Clinics

Childcare Centers

**Advanced Manufacturing Facilities**


