Thank you for emailing these questions to us – I can much more easily find the information needed to guide you through the process. I will break your request down here:

Good morning, I spoke to you this morning, my name is Bob Barthel ,my property is at 10535 high valley rd. A P N 006-004-22.

For this address, we have a Pre-Application conference that is scheduled for Thursday, August 12 at 3:30pm. The file number is: **PV 21-03**

Can i do a medical collective on my property this year without messing up my application for a commercial cannabis license?

At this point, you are still in the position to decide what you would like to do, as no Use Permit application has been submitted to the County. The first step is to schedule a pre-application conference with us. During this conference, we will advise you on the particulars of your property in relation to commercial cannabis cultivation. As mentioned above, this conference is scheduled for Thursday, August 12 at 3:30pm.

I am not quite sure what a “medical collective” is, but here is some information that might be helpful:

Here are our [license types](#). As you read through these, note that some of the license types are for commercial, and some are for medical purposes.

Please have a look through [Article 27](#) in our Lake County Zoning Ordinance. This is the ordinance that governs commercial and medicinal cannabis in the County of Lake

Pg. 27-113-114 (section at) will have information on what type of information you would need to submit with a **Use Permit** application if you were to submit as a: Corporation, Cannabis Cooperative Association, Limited Liability Company, Limited Partnership, or Trust.

Pg. 27-28 (section z) would have information on if you wanted to engage in Adult Personal Use, Qualified Patient, and Primary Caregiver Cannabis Cultivation. If you wanted to go this route, you would be applying for a **Zoning Permit**, and not a Use Permit.

I believe it's 30 plants max with 5 person 6 plants each ,with a medical card, right?

If you are only going for the Adult Personal Use, Qualified Patient, and Primary Caregiver Cannabis Cultivation (applying for a Zoning Permit only), then the plant count would be:

vii. Cannabis plant limitations:

(a) Qualified patient and primary caregiver: No more than six (6) mature cannabis plants or twelve (12) immature cannabis plants per qualified patient may be planted, cultivated, harvested, dried, or processed at any one time

(b) Personal adult use: No more than six (6) cannabis plants per residence on a lot of record may be planted, cultivated, harvested, dried, or processed at any one time regardless of the number of adults living in the residence. [Article 27 pg. 29, section z]

Is any type of permit req.

Yes, see above.

Also the portion of my property that i want to eventually do part of my cannabis canopy is located on a ridge that has been used as a fire break for years. It is disturbed earth & during the (Complex fire) was again dozed. I would like to scrape of existing dead & regrowing brush and remove the root system. There will be no cutting or filling. Do i need a permit to do this?

Yes, a permit would still be required. Please see our information on [Grading](#) and follow Step One, Two, and Three.
