

## BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, COUNTY OF LAKE, STATE OF CALIFORNIA RESOLUTION NO. 2001-73

## A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING AN UNDERGROUND UTILITY DISTRICT SOUTH MAIN STREET – SODA BAY ROAD, LAKEPORT AREA, COUNTY OF LAKE

1	WHEREAS, Lake County Ordinance Code, Chapter 20, establishes a
2	procedure whereby underground utility districts may be formed; and
3	WHEREAS, on April 17, 2001, the Board of Supervisors of the County
4	of Lake, did meet in a public hearing to ascertain whether the public necessity,
5	health, safety or welfare requires the formation of an underground utility district.
6	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:
7	1. Public necessity, health, safety and welfare requires the removal of
8	poles, overhead wires and associated structures within the area
9	formed on a portion of South Main Street and a portion of Soda Bay
10	Road, in the vicinity of Lakeport, California, as more particularly shown
11	on that certain map marked Exhibit "A", attached hereto, and a copy of
12	which is on file in the office of the County Clerk. Said underground
13	Project shall be accomplished in two Phases (Phases I and II) as
14	delineated on said Exhibit "A"
15	2. August 1, 2003, is hereby fixed as the date on which Phase I
16	affected property owners must be ready to receive underground
17	service. August 1, 2004, is hereby fixed as the date on which
18	Phase II affected property owners must be ready to receive
19	underground service. The removal of all notes, overhead wires and

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associated overhead structures and the underground installation of wires and facilities for supplying electric, communication or similar or associated services within the Underground Utility District shall be completed in two phases, Phase I on or before April 1, 2004, and Phase II on or before April 1, 2005.

- 3. The utility which undertakes underground installation of its facilities shall use the underground conversion allocation computed pursuant to decisions of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California for the purpose of providing to each premise in the Underground Utility District, a maximum of one hundred feet of individual electric service, trenching and conductor, as well as backfill, paving and conduit, if required. The Underground Utility District will also allocate funds to cover up to \$1,500.00 in converting each property owner's electric panels to receive underground service. The District will competitively bid one contract to complete all of the conversions within said described district. Each other serving utility will provide service trenching and conductor in accordance with its tariffs on file with the California Public Utilities Commission or as required by its franchise agreement with the County.
- 4. The building inspector of the County of Lake, is hereby ordered to notify all affected utilities and all persons owning real property within the Boundaries of this District. Notification shall be made by
