## A RESOLUTION SUSPENDING THE REQUIREMENT TO CONNECT TO THE PUBLIC SEWER MAIN FOR 9586 STATE HIGHWAY 29

WHEREAS, Appendix A, "Sewer Use Ordinance Lake County Sanitation District" of the Lake County Municipal Code governs the Lake County Sanitation District (LACOSAN); and

WHEREAS, Article II, Section 205 – Sewer Required requires that the Owner of any building situated within the District and within 200 feet of a public sewer connect said building to the public sewer within 90 days of notice to do so; and

WHEREAS, the subject parcel 9586 State Highway 29, Lower Lake is located approximately 90 feet northerly and across State Highway 29 from the nearest public sewer main; and

WHEREAS, the septic system on 9586 State Highway 29 has failed and due to the proximity of the sewer main connection to the public sewer system would normally be required; and

WHEREAS, the owner of said parcel has obtained 4 quotes ranging in cost from \$96,355 to \$160,000 (all with many exclusions) creating a significant and unreasonable hardship to connect to the public sewer; and

WHEREAS, Article II, Section 204, "Relief on Own Motion" provides that the Board may, on its own motion, find that by reason of special circumstances any provision of the Sewer Use Ordinance should be suspended or modified as applied to a particular premise and may, by resolution, order such suspension or modification for such premises; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors, Lake County Sanitation District, that the Board acknowledges the undue hardship of connecting 9586 State Highway 29, Lower Lake to the public sewer system and through the authority granted within Section 204 of the Sewer Use Ordinance suspends by resolution the requirement of Section 205 to connect 9586 State Highway 29 to the District sewer until such time that the property owner is no longer required to cross the State Highway to connect and the septic system no longer functions.
