<u>Side Letter Agreement with the Lake County Employee Association (LCEA) Unit 03, 04</u> <u>& 05 Regarding Amendment to the October 21, 2021 – June 30, 2025, MOU.</u>

The County wishes to add Juneteenth as a County Declared Holiday. To achieve this, the County and LCEA agree that effective December 6, 2022, Section 4.5.1 Holidays Defined of the LCEA October 21, 2021 – June 30, 2025 MOU, or any successor agreement, shall be adjusted as follows:
