THE COMMUNITY CAN BARELY KEEP THE FRAGILE ROADS MAINTAINED AND THE LARGE TRUCKS HAULING DIRT, GRAVEL, FARM EQUIPMENT, WORKERS AND ADDITIONAL TRAFFIC CANNOT BE SUSTAINED BY THE ROADS.

FOR PLACES WITHOUT WELLS, BIG HEAVY WATER TRUCKS ARE UP AND DOWN ALL SUMMER, LONG ON THE ALREADY COMPROMISED ROAD.

AN AGRICULTURAL PROJECT THE SIZE AND SCALE OF THAT PROPOSED BY THIS CORPORATION * WOULD BE DETRIMENTAL TO DOUBLE EAGLE RANCH SUBDIVISION'S FRAGILE INFRASTRUCTURE AND DEVASTATING TO THE COMMUNITY.

I SINCERELY HOPE THIS DOESN'T HAPPEN.
