Why:

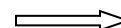
The County of Lake has previously adopted regulations related to Commercial Cannabis permitting and enforcement and has modified those regulations over time to clarify various procedures and expand certain cannabis activities.

It is the desire of the county to ensure that as Commercial Cannabis activities expand and grow in Lake County, the land use provisions regulating such activities are comprehensive and readily understood.

Who:

It is the County's desire to amend the Lake County Zoning Ordinance to address all Commercial Cannabis permitting activities and enforcement as a newly established Article of the Zoning Ordinance.

Community Development Department (Planning, Code Enforcement, and the Building & Safety Divisions) are hosting Commercial Cannabis Workshops to review and highlight the proposed changes by adding Article 73 to Chapter 21 of the Zoning Ordinance.
