I am writing to express my strong support for the Active Transportation Program (ATP) grant application to construct Safe Routes to School infrastructure improvements on and around Lakeshore Boulevard in the City of Lakeport. This project will provide safer routes for neighborhood pedestrians as well as help encourage students to walk to school by linking existing sidewalk gaps and creating new opportunities for walking in and around local schools. When combined with a current sidewalk construction project along Hartley Street, it would add to a growing circuit of safe pedestrian facilities in the area.

This project will provide better access for students living within the City limits, reducing the need for parent drivers and increased traffic in residential neighborhoods. A number of Lakeport students have limited transportation options. Having pedestrian access in the neighborhood can improve their ability to safely travel between home and school.
