4 **RESOLUTION ADOPTING A DISPLAY OF FLAGS POLICY**

6 **WHEREAS**, establishing a policy on the display of flags will provide guidelines for the
7 exhibition of the United States of America flag, the California State flag, and the County of Lake
8 flag at County facilities;

9 **WHEREAS**, establishing the Display of Flags policy will help ensure that flags will be
10 displayed in conformance with Federal and State laws and regulations;

11 **WHEREAS**, the Display of Flags policy affirms that that the County of Lake's flagpoles
12 are not intended to serve as a forum for free expression by the public;

13 **WHEREAS**, the Display of Flags Policy, attached hereto as Attachment 1, provides
14 guidance and the procedure for the display of federal, state, and county flags, as well as the
15 display of ceremonial flags including, but not limited to: flags of significance to the County's
16 history and flags that commemorate special observances.

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18 **NOW THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY OF LAKE AS**
19 **FOLLOWS:**

20 That the Display of Flags Policy, attached hereto as Attachment 1, is hereby approved
21 and adopted, and the County Administrative Officer is directed to number (and
22 renumber, as appropriate) the County Policy and Procedures Manual such that they
23 are organized in a logical fashion.

33. DISPLAY OF FLAGS POLICY

PURPOSE

To establish clear guidelines for: 1) the exhibition of the United States of America flag, the California State flag, the County of Lake flag at County facilities; and 2) the display of ceremonial flags.

POLICY

It is the policy of the County of Lake that flags should be displayed in conformance with Federal and State laws and policies, as stated in the Federal "The Flag" publication of the Congress, Title 4, Chapter, 1 of the United States Code, and the State of California Government Code Sections 430 and 437.

The County's flagpoles are not intended to serve as a forum for free expression by the public. The County will not display a ceremonial flag based on a request from a third party, nor will the County use its flagpoles to sponsor the expression of a third party.

PROCEDURE

Federal, State, and County Flags

- Outdoor flags will be flown at County facilities in the following order of precedence: first, the United States of America flag; second, the California State flag; third, the County of Lake flag.
- The County of Lake flag will be flown wherever there are sufficient poles to do so. The County flag may be displayed on the same pole with, and underneath the State flag, whenever the pole is of sufficient height. The Federal, State, and County flags shall not be flown on a single pole of any height.

Ceremonial Flags

- Ceremonial flags of significance to the County's history may be displayed as designated by Board of Supervisors by adoption of a resolution in conjunction with official actions or proclamations of the Board of Supervisors.
- Ceremonial flags that commemorate special observances must be approved by Board of Supervisors by adoption of a resolution prior to the observance and shall be displayed for a period of time that is reasonable or customary for the subject that is to be commemorated, but no longer than 30 continuous days.
