 - Mitigate Slums and Blight- Community Cleanup Projects
 - Meet an Urgent Need

- Cobb Area Water District Systems Improvements: Summit Area, Hill 9&10, Branding Iron. Serving 1,500 households.
- \$5,597,737 CDBG
- \$1,912,519 State Water Resources Control Board
- Project Completion 8/31/2022

CV- CDBG Business Loans / Job Retention

- CDBG CV-1= \$150,000
 - Three loans in process from \$35,000-\$80,000
- CDBG CV-2&3 \$630,000
 - Three loans in process from \$175,000-\$210,000
- Retention of 22 FTE's
- Goal= Complete Approval Process Within 60 Days



Business Loans & Microenterprise Assistance

➤ CDBG \$415,000

- Four loans in process from \$35,000-\$105,000
- Job Creation= 12 FTE's
- Goal+ Complete Loan Process in 60 days

➤ CDBG \$232,500

- Technical Assistance to 15 Small Businesses and Startups in Workshops & One on Ones
