## AN ORDINANCE ADDING ARTICLE X TO CHAPTER 5 OF THE LAKE COUNTY CODE AND ADOPTING A WATER EFFICIENT LANDSCAPE ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the County of Lake to promote water conservation and to prevent the waste of water whenever and wherever possible; and

WHEREAS, landscape design, installation, maintenance, and management can and should be water efficient; and

WHEREAS, Government Code section 65595 requires the County to either adopt a water efficient landscape ordinance that is at least as effective in conserving water as the Model Water Efficient Landscape Ordinance adopted by the State or to adopt and enforce the State model ordinance.

NOW THEREFORE, the Lake County Board of Supervisors ordains as follows:

Section 1: Article X is hereby added to Chapter 5 of the Lake County Code to read as follows:

"Article X MODEL WATER EFFICIENT LANDSCAPE ORDINANCE.

Sec. 5-43. The updated Model Water Efficient Landscape Ordinance, Sections 490-495, Chapter 2.7, Division 2, Title 23 in the California Code of Regulations, which may be referred to in this Code as the MWELO, as promulgated by the California Department of Water Resources, as may be amended, is hereby adopted and incorporated by reference into the Lake County Code. One copy of the MWELO is on file and available for use by the public in the Building Division of the Community Development Department."

Section 2: The proposed ordinance is categorically exempt under a Class 7 Categorical Exemption pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15307 which exempts actions taken by regulatory agencies as authorized by state law or local ordinance to assure the maintenance, restoration, enhancement, or protection of a natural resource where the regulatory process involves procedures for protection of the

1	environment, because adoption of the MWELO assures the protection of water
2	resources. As a separate and independent basis, the proposed ordinance is
3	exempt under CEQA Guidelines section 15061(b)(3) because it can be seen with
4	certainty that the project will have no significant effect on the environment.
5	Section 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby
6	repealed to the extent of such conflict and no further.
7	Section 4: This ordinance shall take effect on theday of, 2022 and
8	before the expiration of fifteen days after its passage, it shall be published at least
9	once in a newspaper of general circulation printed and published in the County of
10	Lake.
