A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE GRANT PROJECT – LAKE COUNTY CHILD ADVOCACY CENTER PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the County of Lake desires to undertake a project designated as the Lake County Child Advocacy Center Program, to be funded by pass-through federal grant monies administered by the California Office of Emergency Services (Cal OES) for the grant period April 1, 2023 through March 31, 2024; and

WHEREAS, while this grant was non-competitive for the five previously awarded grant periods, from April 2018 through March 2023, there is a change commencing with the 2023-2024 grant period, where applications will now be awarded on a competitive basis; and

WHEREAS, the current position of Forensic Interviewer in Budget Unit 2113 is a limited term position and is dependent on the existence of these grant funds; and

WHEREAS, a total project cost of \$110,000 is being requested in the grant application; and WHEREAS, a request to waive the 20% match requirement of \$22,000 will be submitted with this grant application.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Office of the Lake County District Attorney, is authorized, on the County's behalf, to submit the application for pass-through federal funds for the Lake County Child Advocacy Center Program; and that the Chair of the Board of Supervisors is authorized to sign the Grant Subaward Certification of Assurance of Compliance which is attached hereto and incorporated by reference herein as Exhibit "A" and comply to all of the conditions therein. This certification is a required document of the application.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon award of the grant by Cal OES, the County of Lake authorizes the Lake County District Attorney to sign, in the name of the County of Lake, the following three documents: (1) Exhibit "A", (2) the Federal Fund Grant Subaward Assurances attached hereto and incorporated by reference herein as Exhibit "B", and (3) the Grant Subaward Face Sheet attached hereto and incorporated by reference herein as Exhibit "C", as well as any extensions and amendments thereto which do not substantially alter the County's obligations under the terms of the agreement and/or the Cal OES grant. It is agreed that this grant may reimburse program costs up to \$110,000.
