Canopy and cultivation areas were scaled back. After speaking with the project consultant, Trey Sherrell it was determined the COA's were written for project scope prior to changes that were made. See note below.

Michael McGinnis made use reduce the proposed canopy area from 10.9 acres to 9.9 acres to provide a 1,000-foot setback from the Public Lands of Clear Lake. We also removed the proposed Harvest Storage Areas, as they are unnecessary since processing will occur offsite. That is the reason for the reduction in cultivation and canopy areas.
