RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF LAKE ADOPTING AN
AMENDED CONFLICT OF INTEREST CODE FOR THE COUNTY OF LAKE

WHEREAS, the Political Reform Act, Government Code Sections 81000-91015, requires each state and local government agency to adopt and promulgate a Conflict of Interest Code.

WHEREAS, the Fair Political Practices Commission (FPPC) has adopted a regulation, found in Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 18730 which contains the terms of a standard Conflict of Interest Code, which can be incorporated by reference. After public notice and hearing, the standard code may be amended by the FPPC to conform to amendments in the Political Reform Act. Therefore, the terms of Title 2, California Code of Regulations section 18730 and any amendments to it, duly adopted by the Fair Political Practices Commission, are hereby incorporated by reference.

WHEREAS, the most recent revision to the list of designated employees under the County Conflict of Interest Code was approved by Resolution No. 2015-74 on May 26, 2015;

WHEREAS, the position allocations and assignments of departments have changed since that time, making it necessary to revise and update the list of designated employees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1. The Conflict of Interest Code adopted by Resolution No. 2015-74 is hereby repealed in its entirety.
2. The proposed amended Conflict of Interest Code, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference, is hereby adopted.
