Proclamation

HONORING ERIC SEELY FOR HIS YEARS OF DEDICATED SERVICE TO LAKE COUNTY

WHEREAS, Eric Seely graduated from Upper Lake High School in 1984 and returned to Lake County in 1989 to pursue a career in the Agricultural industry and after many successful years in agricultural, Eric Seely began working for the County of Lake in December of 2005 with the Lake County Redevelopment Agency; and

WHEREAS, as a Project Manager with the Lake County Redevelopment Agency, Eric Seely was responsible for the management and oversight of several County projects, including: the Clearlake Oaks Plaza Project, the Ely Historical Stage Stop Agricultural Museum, and the acquisition of property for the Lucerne Harbor Park; and

WHEREAS, Eric Seely was promoted to Deputy Redevelopment Director in January, 2007, and in that capacity was responsible for management and oversight of several of the North Shore's significant projects, including: the Lucerne Third Avenue Plaza, the Lucerne Harbor Village, the Nice Holiday Harbor purchase and redevelopment, the Clearlake Oaks Clarks Island acquisition and renovation, the Eskaton Senior Housing Project, and the Upper Lake Main Street Reconstruction and Redevelopment; and

WHEREAS, Eric Seely was promoted to Deputy County Administrative Officer in January 2012, and in that capacity was responsible for the management and oversight of the historic Lucerne Hotel renovation for Marymount College, the construction of the Middletown Library and Senior Center, and the construction of Clearlake Oaks Senior Center; and

WHEREAS, Eric Seely accepted the Right of Way/Airport Operations Coordinator position with the Department of Public Works in October, 2014, and has been responsible for the acquisition of right of way for numerous bridge replacement projects, the Clearlake Oaks Sidewalk project, the Konocti Road Safe Routes to School project, and the South Main Street/Soda Bay Road Improvement Project, along with coordinating all activities and planning at Lampson Field; and

WHEREAS, in a testament to Eric Seely's dedication, he has chosen to return to his family's heritage to continue a legacy of agriculture that began with his grandfather in the 1950's.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Lake does hereby commend Eric Seely for his many years of outstanding and dedicated service to the County of Lake and the citizens of Lake County, and express our most sincere appreciation to Eric for his many contributions toward the betterment of Lake County over the past eleven years.
