Proclamation

DESIGNATING THE WEEK OF APRIL 3-9, 2017 AS PUBLIC HEALTH WEEK

WHEREAS, the week of April 3-9, 2017 is National Public Health Week, with the theme: Healthiest Nation 2030; and

WHEREAS, Public Health Week celebrates the role of public health in educating and empowering communities to improve health, prevent illness and increase preparedness for disaster and educates with regard to emergency preparedness before real or man-made disasters occur will help save lives; and

WHEREAS, public health utilizes cost effective programs to promote greater knowledge and awareness of positive health behaviors contributing significantly to the reduction of needless suffering; and

WHEREAS, Public Health Week provides an opportunity to exponentially increase the impact of public health education in Lake County with an emphasis on disease prevention, health promotion, health education and emergency preparedness; and
