

Lakeport Sprint Boat Grand Prix

APRIL 10, 2017

RACE COURSE DESIGN DETAIL (REVISION 1):

- Clear Lake shoreline and seawall is a natural vertical barrier
- Distance from outside course markers (exterior course line) is minimum 250' to spectators.
- Insurance minimum is 150'.
- Current SCSC race courses, Long Beach, Ca. and Parker, Az., run courses set to the exact measurements required by insurers (150' minimum).
- SBGP Course outside parameter distances will be a minimum of 250' from outside of the race course to a line of buoys and boats with signs saying KEEP OUT Race in progress.
- Race officials will work with Sheriff's Marine Patrol to establish and maintain a race boundaries footprint that is not compromised by other non-event related watercraft.

The northern side of the course and turn 4 has been moved north to an area adjacent to the event parking area (minimum of 250' from race course to shoreline). This means no boats will be entering or exiting turn 4 on a line with spectators. No people will be allowed near the parking area shoreline when there is racing in progress. In addition, a line of cement K-Rail barriers will be set at the shoreline to protect this area.

NOTE: The above detail will support the SBGP race course design presented to Lake County Water Resources Dept. on 4/10/17 and designated to SBGP RACE COURSE DESIGN (REVISION 1).
