RESOLUTION APPROVING THE ELECTION DATE CHANGE FOR GOVERNING BOARD MEMBERS ON THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF MENDOCINO-LAKE COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT FROM ODD-NUMBERED YEARS TO THE SAME DAY AS THE STATEWIDE GENERAL ELECTION HELD IN EVEN-NUMBERED YEARS

**RESOLVED** by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Lake, State of California, that it finds, determines and hereby declares THAT:

WHEREAS, California Elections Code §10405.7 authorizes a governing board of a community college district to adopt and submit a resolution requesting that the community college district's governing board member election be consolidated with the statewide election to the Board of Supervisors no later than 240 days prior to the community college district's current scheduled governing board member election in November, 2017; and,

**WHEREAS,** the Mendocino-Lake Community College District Board of Trustees has adopted a resolution requesting that the Lake County Board of Supervisors consider changing the Community College District's Governing Board Member Elections from odd-numbered years to even-numbered years; and,

**WHEREAS,** the Mendocino-Lake Community College District's Resolution was submitted and accepted by the Board of Supervisors at their regular meeting on March 7, 2017; and,

**WHEREAS,** the Registrar of Voters has determined that the change of election date will not cause the ballot layout, computer capacity or voter equipment to be exceeded with the consolidation of the Mendocino-Lake Community College District's Governing Board Member Elections; and,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED pursuant to Section 10405.7 of the Elections Code, State of California, the Lake County Board of Supervisors approves Mendocino-Lake Community College District Board of Trustee's request to change the Community College District's Governing Board Member Elections from odd-numbered years to even-numbered years and authorizes the Lake County Registrar of Voters to move the Mendocino-Lake Community College District's odd-year election and consolidate the Community College District's Elections with the Statewide General Election commencing with the November 6, 2018 General Election and those Governing Board Members on the Board of Trustees whose terms would have expired in 2017 and 2019 shall continue in their offices for an additional year.
