RESOLUTION PROHIBITING PARKING ON STATE HIGHWAY 20 IN  
LUCERNE

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Section 22505 of the Vehicle Code, the Department of Transportation may determine that the parking of vehicles along the east side of State Highway 20 in Lake County within 20-feet of the southeast corner with First Street in the community of Lucerne obstructs visibility to those using said Highway, and that the parking of vehicles thereon, unless prohibited or restricted as herein provided would unduly interfere with the free movement of traffic and pedestrians thereon.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Lake resolves and finds as follows:

1. That pursuant to the authority in Section 22506 of the Vehicle Code and the above finding, the parking of vehicles along the east side of State Highway 20 in Lake County within 20-feet of the southeast corner with First Street in the community of Lucerne, be prohibited at any time; and
2. The appropriate signs be placed on said State Highway, and existing curbs be painted red, evidencing the provisions of this Resolution and that said Resolution shall be effective upon the approval of the Department of Transportation and the erection of such signs and painting of curbs.


