A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE EXIT OF LAKE COUNTY FROM TITLE IV-E CHILD WELFARE WAIVER DEMONSTRATION PROJECT EFFECTIVE SEPTEMBER 30, 2017

WHEREAS, on March 31, 2006; the State of California received approval for the California Title IV-E Child Welfare Demonstration Project from the federal Department of Health and Human Services; and

WHEREAS, in September 2014, the State of California received approval to extend the Demonstration Project for an additional five years; and

WHEREAS, the State of California is operating a State Demonstration Project pursuant to Welfare and Institutions Code, Section 18200 et. seq. for the County Demonstration emphasizing child and family well-being that will support practice programs and system improvements that may result in better outcomes for children, youth, and families; and

WHEREAS, the Lake County Department of Social Services (LCDSS), in partnership with the Probation Department, executed an agreement with the California Department of Social Services to participate in the Title IV-E Child Welfare Waiver Demonstration Project commencing October 1, 2014 through September 30, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the LCDSS projects that continued participation in the Title IV-E Child Welfare Waiver Demonstration Project will require unanticipated county funding; and

WHEREAS, the Lake County Board of Supervisors has designated the LCDSS as the lead 1 agency responsible for contractual relationships with partner organizations and the State for the 2 Title IV-E Child Welfare Waiver Demonstration Project; and 3 4 WHEREAS, the California Department of Social Services requires' the Lake County Board of 5 Supervisors to approve the exit from the Title IV-E Child Welfare Waiver Demonstration Project 6 through a formal resolution process. 7 8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Lake County Board of Supervisors hereby approves the LCDSS' request to exit from the Title IV-E Child Welfare Waiver Demonstration 10 Project effective September 30, 2017; and 11 12 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Lake County Board of Supervisors that the Lake County 13 Administrative Officer, or his/her designee, is hereby authorized and empowered to apply, 14 approve, sign, and execute in the name of the County of Lake any documents necessary to 15 exercise the Title IV-E Child Welfare Waiver Demonstration Project opt-out election; and 16 17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution shall remain in full force and effect until a 18 resolution by the Lake County Board of Supervisors is adopted amending or rescinding this 19 resolution. 20 21 PASSED AND ADOPTED by the Lake County Board of Supervisors this 25th day of July, 2017 22 by the following vote: 23 24 AYES: 25 NOES: 26 **ABSENT OR NOT VOTING:** 27 29
