# AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING AND PRESCRIBING SEWER SERVICE CHARGES FOR ANDERSON SPRINGS

The Board of Directors of the Lake County Sanitation District, State of California ordains as follows:

## ARTICLE I. GENERAL PROVISIONS

- 1.1 <u>Short Title</u>. This ordinance may be cited as "Anderson Springs Sewer Service Charge Ordinance."
- 1.2 <u>Definitions.</u> Unless the context otherwise indicates, terms used herein have the following meanings:
  - (a) "District" means Anderson Springs Sewer System
- (b) "Sewer service charges" means fees, tolls, rates, rentals or other charges for services and facilities furnished by District in connection with its sanitary sewerage system.
- 1.3 <u>Separability</u>. This Board hereby declares that it would have passed this ordinance and each section, sub-section, sentence, clause or phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more of the sections, sub-sections, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitutional.
- 1.4 <u>Inconsistent Ordinance and Regulations</u>. All ordinances and regulations or parts of ordinances and regulations inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

## ARTICLE II. SEWER SERVICE CHARGES

2.1 <u>Rate Schedule.</u> Sewer service charges are hereby prescribed in accordance with the schedule of charges set forth as follows:

- (1) RESIDENTIAL- Base Charge
  Includes: Each dwelling unit with sewer connections on
  the same parcel; House, Mobile home, Apartment,
  Granny Unit, occupied cabins or travel trailers with
  sewer service and any additional auxiliary unit (hooked up)
- (2) COMMUNITY OR COMMERCIAL ESTABLISHMENT Base Charge \$37.38
  Includes: Professional office, Small Retail, Daycare or Day school
  w/o cafeteria or showers, Fellowship hall or church w/o commercial kitchen,
  coffee shop w/o kitchen; Community Center

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	(3) Additional Units through a single connection \$37.38
	(4) Capital Improvement Program Fee Per SFD equivalent \$14.45
1	The above sewer charges, items 1 through 3, including monthly charges, shall be adjusted
2	February 15 of each year based on inflation. The inflationary adjustment shall be determined
	by multiplying the current rate by the ratio of the prior year's average annual U.S. City Average Consumer Price Index as published by the U.S. Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics.
3	In the event of a negative index, no change in the sewer charges shall be made. The Consumer
4	Price Index inflationary adjustment is publicized annually by February 1st on Special Districts
5	website.
6	2.2 <u>Use of Revenues</u> . Revenues derived under this ordinance shall be used only for the
7	acquisition, construction and reconstruction, maintenance and operation and or replacement of
0	sanitation or sewerage facilities of the District.
8	All ordinances or resolutions in conflict herewith are repealed to the extent of such conflict and
9	no further.
10	This Ordinance shall take effect on the day of, 2017
11	and before the expiration of fifteen (15) days after its passage, a summary shall be published at least once
	in a newspaper of general circulation printed and published in the County of Lake.
