4 **RESOLUTION CONFIRMING EXISTENCE OF A LOCAL EMERGENCY**

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6 WHEREAS, Section 6-5 of the Lake County Code empowers the Director of Emergency
7 Services to proclaim the existence or threatened existence of a local emergency when said
8 County is affected or likely to be affected by a public calamity and the Board of Supervisors is
9 not in session, subject to ratification by the Board of Supervisors within seven days; and

10 WHEREAS, conditions of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property have arisen
11 within this county, caused by the Sulphur Fire Incident which originated in the Clearlake Oaks
12 area and has progressed to surrounding areas including Clearlake, commencing on or about
13 12:55 a.m. on October 9, 2017, at which time the Board of Supervisors of the County of Lake
14 was not in session; and

15 WHEREAS, the Director of Emergency Services of the County of Lake did proclaim the
16 existence of a local emergency within said county on the 9th day of October, 2017; and

17 WHEREAS, said Board of Supervisors does hereby find that the aforesaid conditions of
18 extreme peril did warrant and necessitate the proclamation of the existence of a local emergency.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY PROCLAIMED and ordered that said local
20 emergency shall be deemed to continue to exist until its termination is proclaimed by the Board
21 of Supervisors of the County of Lake, State of California.
