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## RESOLUTION PERTAINING TO THE RESTORATION OR RECONSTRUCTION OF NON-CONFORMING BUILDINGS OR STUCTURES DESTROYED BY THE SULPHUR FIRE

WHEREAS, the Governor proclaimed a state of emergency exists in Lake County due to the Sulphur Fire; and

WHEREAS, the Sulphur Fire is estimated to have destroyed 223 structures; including 137 single-family homes, and 86 other structures such as sheds and smaller outbuildings; and

WHEREAS, Article 59 Section 59.9 requires that a non-conforming building or structure is destroyed by a fire to the extent of fifty-one (51) percent or more may be restored or reconstructed to allow continuation of the same non-conforming use only upon first securing a major use permit; and

WHEREAS, securing a major use permit is a lengthy process and adds additional cost to the rebuilding or reconstruction of such a building or structure,

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that:

- Article 59, Section 59.9 requirement that a major use permit requirement for the rebuilding or reconstruction of a destroyed, non-conforming building or structure is deferred for such structures destroyed in the Sulphur Fire for a period of two years from the date of this resolution.
- 2. The non-conformity shall not be increased, i.e. the rebuilding or reconstruction shall not increase the footprint of the building or structure.
- 3. The Community Development Department shall take appropriate actions to inform the public of this policy.
- 4. The Community Development Director shall monitor the implementation of this policy and shall report back to the Board on a regular basis not to exceed annually.
