RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ACCESS TO STATE AND LOCAL SUMMARY CRIMINAL HISTORY INFORMATION BY THE DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SERVICES

WHEREAS, Penal Code Section 11105, subdivision (b)(10) and Section 13300, subdivision (b)(10) authorize access to state and local summary criminal history information by a county or an official thereof if access is needed to assist a county agency or officer in fulfilling employment, certification, or licensing duties; and

WHEREAS, the above-cited code sections require that said access be specifically authorized by the Board of Supervisors when such criminal history information is required to implement a statute, regulation, or ordinance that expressly refers to specific criminal conduct applicable to the person who is the subject of the information sought and contains requirements and/or exclusions expressly based on the specified criminal conduct.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED that:

The Board hereby authorizes the Lake County Department of Social Services to access both state and local summary criminal history information for employment purposes in the Children's Services Program.
