Hi All,

I didn't want to use precious time yesterday on minor stuff, but wanted to pass along some minor comments:

1. Page 37 Line 9. For the six months for the Early Activation, I think it makes sense for the Director to be able to extend that if the process drags on by no fault of the applicant. Otherwise it might expire during the growing season.
2. Page 40 Line 21, I think you mean "Minor or Major" not "Minor or Minor".
3. I don't have the page number but it says licensee records must be kept on the premises. I think it might be a good idea to say "or on property" since an office or residence may be a more practical place to keep paperwork.

I do have a question about early activation that came out of the presentation yesterday. Is Early Activation available for all commercial cultivation license types? And, I think I heard it said that Early Activation is basically a minor use permit. Is that correct, and if so does that mean Early Activation requires a Planning Commission Hearing? It would seem to me that this should be administrative.

Finally, the letter from Bradley Johnson makes a lot of sense and I highly recommend adopting his recommendations.

With that all said, I want to thank you three and the rest of the staff for the herculean effort you have put forward in moving this forward. We are all very grateful!
